


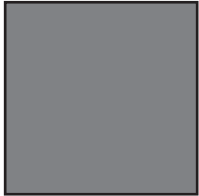


Pattern printing and assembly tips:

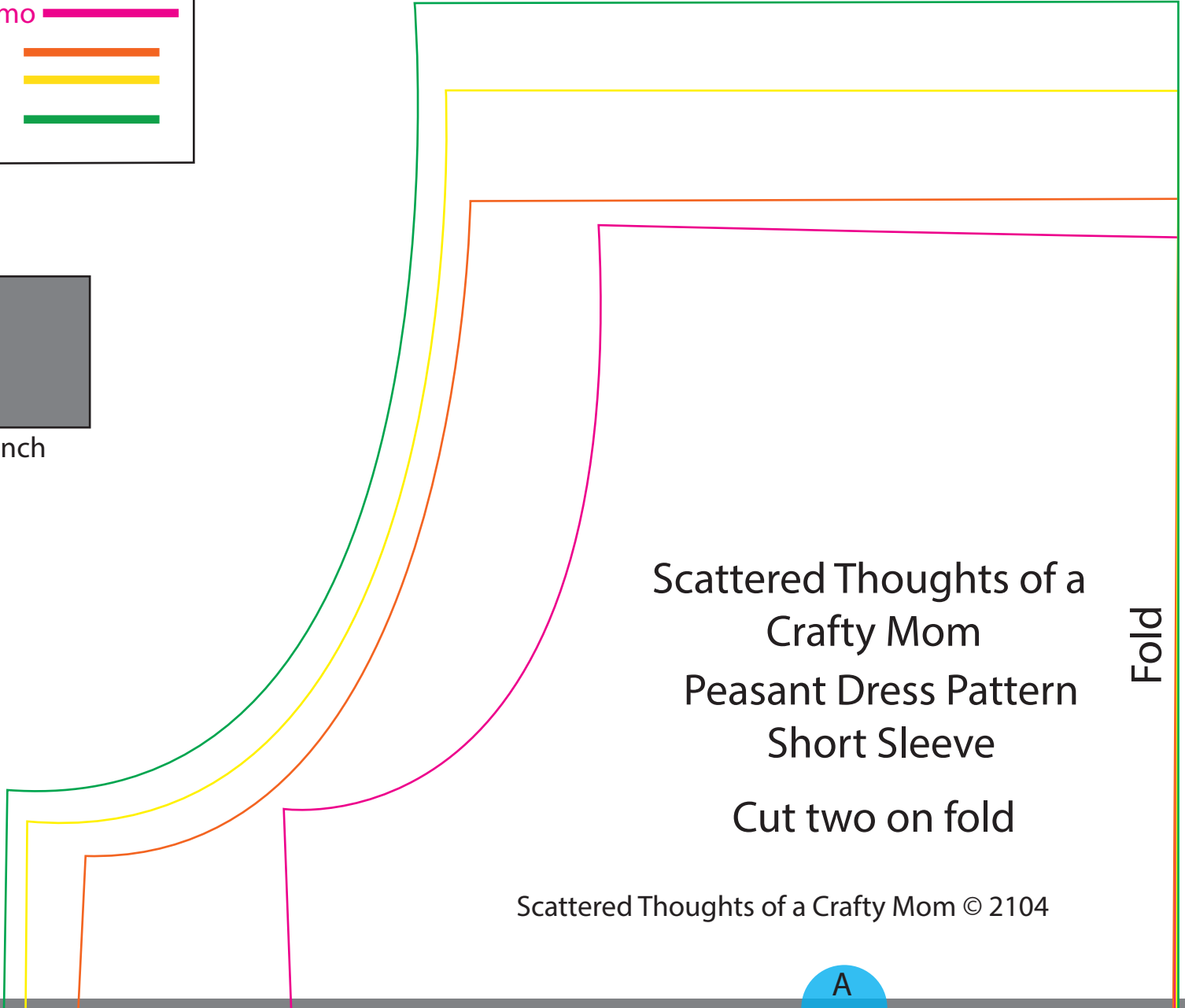
1. Download pattern to your pc
2. Open with Adobe Acrobat Reader
3. Turn off all formatting and print
4. Cut out each block around the outer gray edge and align the gray boxes, edge to edge (don't overlap.)
5. Tape pattern together and cut out size needed.

7. This pattern is free for you to use and you may sell items you make on a small scale. (Just dont use my photos to sell your products.)

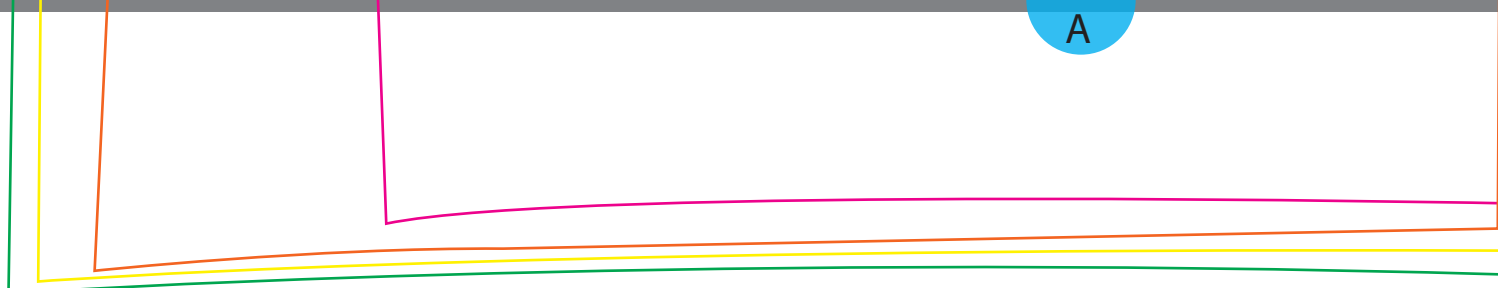

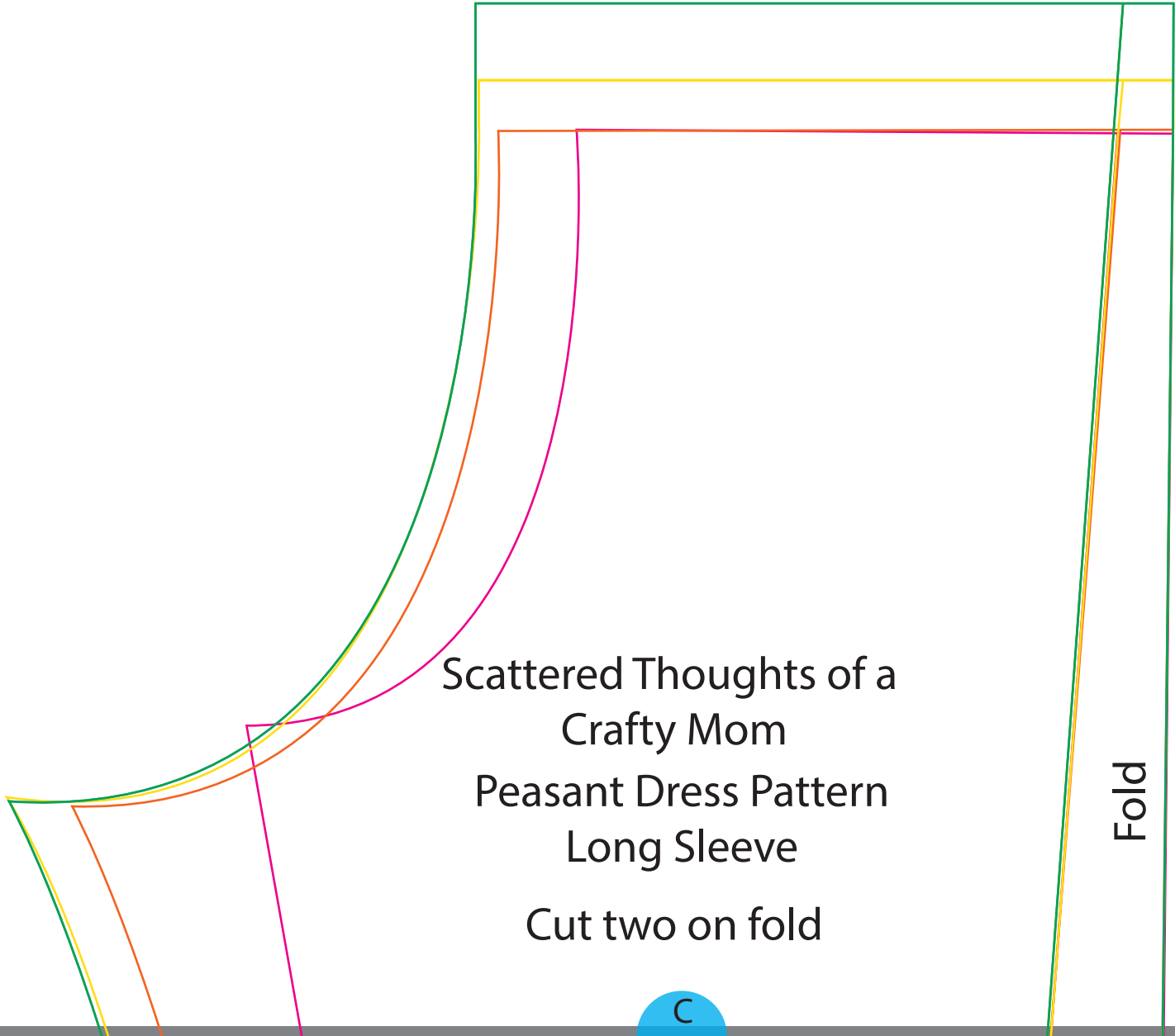
