Materials:

- •Red heart "Designer Sport": lime, pink, white, or color of choice or any Dk yarn of choice.
- Crochet hook suitable for the yarn you use (I use a C or D) USA hook
- one pair of 9mm. safety eyes
- Yarn Needle
- Polyester fiber fill
- Optional: Hot glue gun and glue sticks
- * Polyester fiber fill or stuffing of choice
- *

Finished Size: Approximately 61/2" tall

Your finished Kitty, may finish bigger or smaller than mine depending on your tension, hook size and the yarn you use.

Abbreviation I use:

- 1. = Round
- ch = chain
- sc = single crochet
- inc = increase (2sc in same stitch)
- dec = decrease (2sc worked together)
- sl st = slip stitch(es)
- FO = fasten off yarn, lv tail for sewing
- BLO = back loop only of next stitch

* = repeat directions between * and * as many times as indicated

(= repeat directions between (and) as many times as indicated

I start crochet by making an Adjustable ring as in Japanese style. It makes the starting hole tight and secure. You can start in which ever way you feel comfortable.

NOTE: Work in continuous spiral round; do not join rounds unless otherwise stated. Mark first stitch of each round, If the number goes up on the next row, increase to that number of stitches, if the number goes down, decrease to that number of stitches.

Note: Amigurumi is worked in rounds instead of rows, place a marker at the beginning of each row, to help with counting so you don't loose your place. Begin with an Adjustable Ring at each section.

LEGS and BODY: Make 2 in color of choice

Note: Using Polyester fiber fill stuff as you crochet each part

Make a magic ring with 6 sc or ch-2 and work 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook
sc inc 1, repeat from * to * 5 times (12)
3-14. sc 12
15. hold the two legs together and sc around (24)
16-21. sc 24 around
22. * sc 2, sc dec 1 * repeat from * to * 6 times (18)
23. sc 18 around , FO lv long yarn tail for sewing head to body

HEAD: Make 1 in color of choice

- 1. . Make a magic ring with 6 sc or ch-2 and work 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook
- 2. *sc inc 1*, repeat from * to * 5 times (12)
- 3. * sc 1, sc inc 1 * repeat from * to * 6 times (18)
- 4. * sc 2, sc inc 1 * repeat from * to * 6 times (24)
- 5. * sc 3 sc inc 1 * repeat from * to * 6 times (30)
- 6. * sc 4, sc inc 1 * repeat from * to * 6 times (36)
- 7. * sc 5, sc inc 1 * repeat from * to * 6 times (42)
- 8-11. sc around (42)
- 12. * sc 5, sc dec 1 * repeat from * to * 6 times (36)
- 13. * sc 4, sc dec 1 * repeat from * to * 6 times (30)
- 14. * sc 3, sc dec 1 * repeat from * to * 6 times (24)
- 15. * sc 2, sc dec 1 * repeat from * to * 6 times (18)

FO, weave ends in. Sew body to head.

ARMS: Make 2 in color of choice

- 1. . Make a magic ring with 5 sc or ch-2 and work 5 sc in 2nd ch from hook
- 2. sc inc 1, in each st, total of 5 times (10)
- 3-8. sc around (10) add a bit of stuffing for Paw.(do not stuff all the way up the arm!)

9. *sc dec, sc 4* repeat * to * one more time (8) 10-11. sc 8 FO , lv yarn tail to sew to sides of body

EARS: Make 2 in color of choice

- 1. Make a magic ring with 3 sc
- 2. *sc inc 1* sc 1, repeat from * to * once more (5)
- 3. *sc inc 1*, repeat from * to * 4 times (10)
- 4-5. sc 10 around. FO, lv yarn tail to sew to Kittens head

TAIL: Make 1 in color of choice

- 1. Make a magic ring with 6 sc or ch-2 and work 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook
- 2-9. sc around (6)

FO lv yarn tail to sew to back of Kitten body. Do not stuff!

OPTIONAL: you may tie a ribbon around your kitten"s neck, or crochet a little

flower to attach to your kitten's head or neck.

HINT: if you knit a nice little tail can be worked up with a 3 stitch I-Cord about 4 inches in length.
