

On February 21, 2008, amendments to Regulation 637, Pesticide Use, were filed with the Secretary of State, and were published in the March 15, 2008 Michigan Register. Regulation 637 was initially promulgated in 1992 and since that time it has never been amended. The rulemaking process for Regulation 637 began in April 2005 when a rulemaking committee comprised of representatives from all affected industry sectors... This information complements the contact list of persons requiring notification due to medical conditions as required under Regulation 637, Rule 5.
