### What you will need:

AUNT LYDIA'S® Classic Crochet Thread, Size 10: 1 ball 484 Myrtle Green

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook: 2.25mm [US B-1].

Stitch marker, 1 small button, yarn needle, spray starch

**GAUGE:** 32 dc = 4" (10cm). **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.



AUNT LYDIA'S® Classic Crochet Thread, Size 10, Art. 154 available in white & ecru 400 yd; solid color 250 yd; shaded color 300 yd balls



## Moderne Crochet Floral Collar

*Instead of the usual necklace, change up your style with this lovely crocheted piece. It buttons in the back, making it easy to add to any dress or top.*

Collar measures 19" (48cm) long

### COLLAR

#### Flower (make 2)

Ch 3, join in a ring with a slip st. Place marker.

**Round 1:** Ch 3 (counts as dc), work 9 dc in ring. Join to top of ch 3 with slip st—10 dc.

**Round 2:** Ch 1, (sc, ch 7, sc, ch 1) in same st, \*skip 1 dc, (sc, ch 7, sc, ch 1) in next dc; repeat from \* around. Join to first sc with slip st—5 petals.

**Round 3:** Ch 1, (sc, 2 hdc, 3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc, 2 hdc, sc) in each ch-7 space around. Join to first sc with slip st. Set aside.

### Neckband

Ch 122.

**Row 1:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch—121 sts.

**Row 2:** Ch 3 (counts as dc), \*dc in next st, 2 dc in next st; repeat from \* across—181 sts.

**Row 3:** Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), skip 1 dc, dc in next st, \*ch 1, skip 1 st, dc in next st; repeat from \* across.

**Row 4:** Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), dc in dc, \*ch 1, dc in dc; repeat from \* across.

**Row 5:** Ch 3 (counts as dc), dc in each dc and ch-1 space across.

**Row 6:** \*Slip st in next st, skip 4 sts, [ch 1, tr] 7 times in next st, ch 1, skip 4 sts; \*\* repeat from \* 7 more times, slip st in next st, [ch 3, slip st in ch-2 space on flower petal, ch 3, skip 3 sts, slip st in next st, ch 3, slip st in ch-2 space on next flower petal of same flower, ch 3, skip 3 sts, slip st in next st] twice, repeat from \* to \*\* 8 times (omit first slip st on first repeat only), end slip st in last st.

**Row 7:** Sc in ch-1 space, \*ch 3, sc in next ch-1 space; repeat across to top of 8th scallop, ch 3, sc in first unattached ch-2 space of flower petal, ch 3, [sc in next dc, ch

3] twice, [sc in first dc of next petal, ch 3, sc in next dc, ch 3, sc in ch-2 space, ch 3, sc in next dc, ch 3] twice, sc in ch-2 space of next petal, ch 3, sc in ch-2 space of 2nd flower, ch 3, [sc in first dc of next petal, ch 3, sc in next dc, ch 3, sc in ch-2 space, ch 3, sc in next dc, ch 3, sc in next dc, ch 3] twice, [sc in next dc, ch 3] twice, sc in ch-2 space, ch 3, ch 3 in top of next scallop, \*\*ch 3, sc in next ch-1 space; repeat from \*\* to end. Fasten off.

Sew button to one edge at neck. Use first dc st as button loop.

Weave in ends. Block and starch.

### ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain; dc = double crochet; hdc = half double crochet; sc = single crochet; sl st = slip stitch; st(s) = stitch(es); [ ] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; \* = repeat whatever follows the \* as indicated.
