EMBROIDERY INSTRUCTIONS

02874 Letter to Santa Claus

Some $\frac{1}{4}$ **Cross** stitches have been charted in this design to create the shape of the face. One quarter **Cross** stitches are recognizable when two symbols appear within one block on the Chart, or when a tiny symbol ^{Pinkec} appears in the corner of a block bordered by a **Back** stitch. Consult the stitch diagrams when working $\frac{1}{4}$ **Cross** stitches.

To begin working **Cross** stitches, find the square which represents the center of the fabric. This square is indicated by arrows outside the design area on the Chart. Begin working near this point following charted symbols for correct color placement. When working **Cross** stitches be sure each top stitch of the **Cross** slants in the same direction.

OTHER STITCHING

Heavy lines on the Chart indicate **Back** and **Straight** stitching. Work 2-ply **Straight** stitches of med. dk. brown to create the hair and eyebrow. Two-ply med. dk. brown **Back** stitches create the sled rope. • Use 2-ply of dk. maroon to **Back** stitch the scarf fringe; two stray fringe ends by the face are 2-ply **Straight** stitches of the same color. • The profile of the face, side of the eye and signature are **Back** stitched using 2-ply of med. brown. Punctuate the signature with 2-ply **French Knots** of the same color. • All other **Back** stitching is done using 1-ply of dk. brown.

PERSONALIZATION

Using the alphabet provided, work name out on graph paper first to assure proper spacing. On our alphabet chart, squares containing a dot should be left unstitched. Center name at top of stocking where indicated by an inverted "T". Use 2-ply **Cross** stitches of dk. salmon red to complete the name.

ORNAMENT

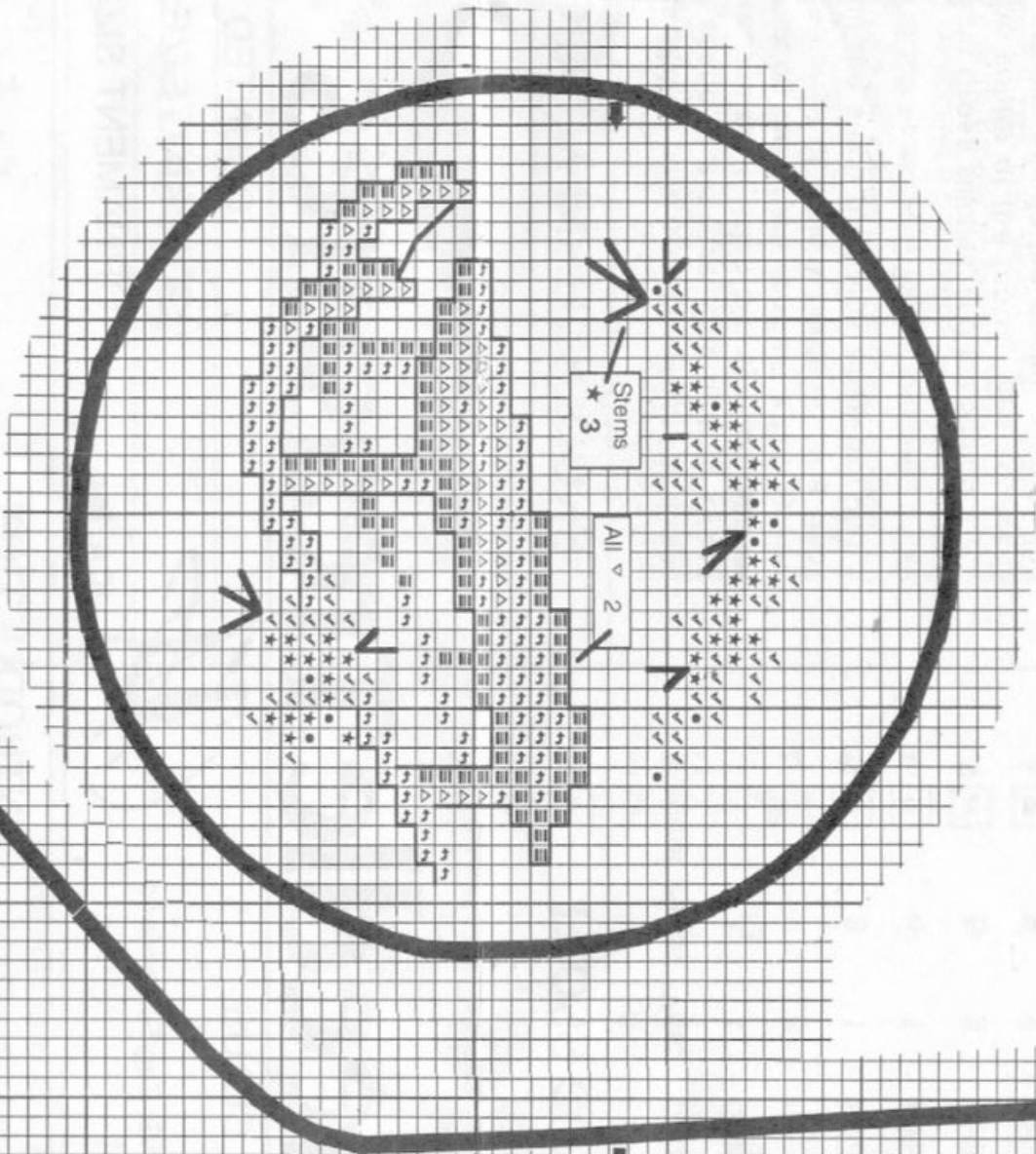
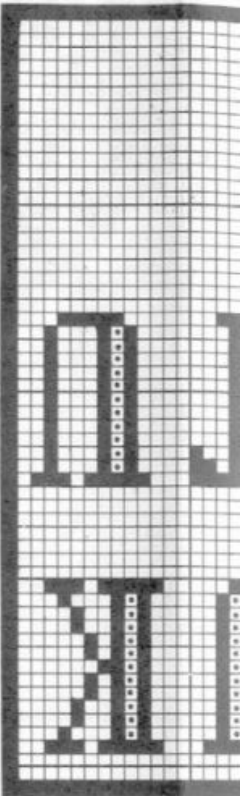
The ornament is worked in the same manner as the stocking. Heavy lines denote **Back** and **Straight** stitching. Use 2-ply of dk. green to **Straight** stitch needles extending from the spray of greenery. All other **Back** stitching is accomplished using 1-ply of dk. brown.

When stitching of the design is completed, follow the solid lines printed on the Chart to baste the stocking and ornament shapes onto the fabric.

(The charted design is larger than the actual stitched embroidery.)

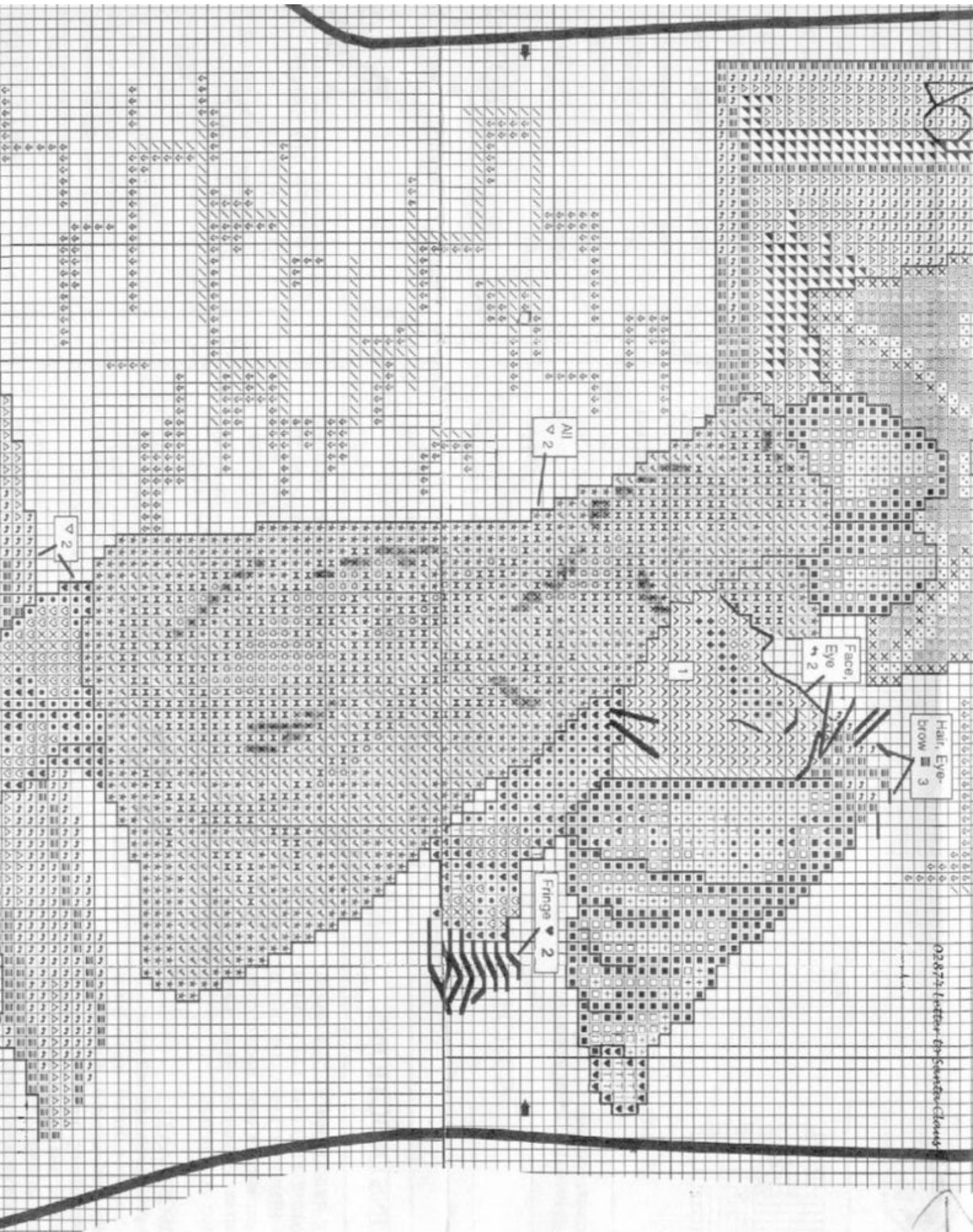
