Katrina Ribbon Cloche

Crochet Pattern



Materials: Stitch Marker, Ribbon

Yarn: Worsted weight yarn (I used cotton)

MC = Main Color - I used country pink (Peaches & Creme)CC = Contrasting Color - I used soft ecru (Peaches & Creme)

BC = Brim Color - I used espresso (Lion Brand Cotton)

Hook size: "J" (6 mm) or to match gauge

Gauge: 15 stitches and 14 rows in sc = 4" x 4" (10 cm x 10 cm)

Abbreviations used:

st or sts - stitch or stitches

ch - chain stitch

sc - single crochet

dc - double crochet

sl st - slip stitch

rnd(s) - round(s)

sp - space

beg - beginning

Magic Ring: You can find directions for the "magic ring" here: http://www.youtube.com/watch?v=FHYVutk2iYY. You do not have to use this method, I give alternate directions if you prefer the traditional way.

Notes: Mark 1st stitch of each rnd for reference and move stitch marker as you complete each rnd. The top of this hat is worked in continuous rounds in order to avoid an unsightly seam. The fit is much looser on the brim, and it comes down to the eyebrows. The cloche style does NOT fit tightly like a beanie.

Top portion of hat:

With MC: You can start with a Magic Ring, 6 sc in ring, join with sl st in 1st sc and proceed to rnd 2 OR: Rnd 1: ch 2, 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook. Join with sl st in 1st sc.

Rnd 2: 2 sc in each st around, do not join but work these next rnds in a continuous spiral. (12 sc)

Rnd 3: (1 sc, 2 sc in next st) all around. (18 sc)

Rnd 4: (1 sc in each of next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st) all around. (24 sc)

Rnd 5: (1 sc in each of next 3 sts, 2 sc in next st) all around. (30 sc)

Rnd 6: (1 sc in each of next 4 sts, 2 sc in next st) all around. (36 sc) <-- end here for 0-3 months

Rnd 7: (1 sc in each of next 5 sts, 2 sc in next st) all around (42 sc) <-- end here for 3-6 months


Rnd 8: (1 sc in each of next 6 sts, 2 sc in next st) all around (48 sc) <-- end here for 6-12 months

Rnd 9: (1 sc in each of next 7 sts, 2 sc in next st) all around (54 sc) <-- end here for child size

Rnd 10: (1 sc in each of next 8 sts, 2 sc in next st) all around (60 sc) <-- end here for adult

First shell rnd: (sl st in next st to finish off previous rnd) ch 3, 2 dc in same st, *skip 2 sts, 4 dc in next st*, repeat between *...* to end of rnd, 1 dc in first st to complete first shell, join with a sl st in top of ch 3.

Shell rnds: ch 3, 2 dc in sp between 2nd and 3rd dc's of previous rnd, *work 4 dc in sp between 2nd and 3rd dc's of next shell in previous rnd*, repeat all around, 1 dc in first st, join with a sl st in top of ch 3.



Repeat above rnd 4 times. (For a newborn, only do 2-3 more rnds)

Ríbbon section:

Switch to CC

Ribbon rnd 1: ch 1, sc in each st all around, sl st in ch 1 to join.

Ribbon rnd 2: ch 4, *skip next st, dc in next st, ch 1*, repeat between *...* to end of rnd. At end you will do one last 'ch 1' and join with sl st in 3rd ch of beg ch 4.

Ribbon rnd 3: ch 1, *sc in next sp from rnd below, sc in top of next dc from rnd below*, repeat between *...* to end of rnd, join with sl st in ch 1.

Brim Section:

Switch to BC

Brim rnd 1: ch 1, sc in each st all around, join with sl st in ch 1. Repeat first rnd 3 or 4 times.

Edging rnd: ch 4, sc in same st as beg ch, *skip next st, (sc, ch 3, sc)* in next st, repeat between *...* all around, sl st in same st as beg ch to join (this will complete the first shell). Fasten off. Weave in all ends. Thread a length of ribbon through openings and tie in a bow.

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
