

## Q-1164 Quilt „Attic Window“ © STOF A/S 2012

Size: approx. 49 x 62½" (ca. 125,5 x 160 cm)

### Fabric:

### The blocks:

**A:** An unlimited assorted colorful number of fabrics. The quilt pictured used all the fabrics from the collection **Quilters Rose 4512**, each 42" (112 cm) wide. If the complete collection is not available use your own color choices. For suggested color combinations, refer to the diagram. For amount of fabric needed, refer to cutting the blocks.

### Sashing and binding:

**B: 4512-903** Black patterned 53" (135 cm)

### Backing and hanging sleeve:

**C: 12-025** Natural, 58" (150 cm) wide 71" (180 cm)

**Batting:** thin, 59" (150 cm) wide 71" (180 cm)

**In addition:** Matching sewing and quilting thread.


### Cutting ➡:

A ¼" (0,75 cm) seam allowance is included.

Refer to the diagram for color combination for squares and trapezoids in the blocks.

**Small block:** (78 x)

Size: 4 x 4" (10,25 x 10,25 cm)




Square **1** 4 x 4" (8,75 x 8,75 cm)

Trapezoid **2** from rectangle  $1 \times 4\frac{7}{8}"$  (4,5 x 12,75) miter right corner.

Trapezoid **3** from rectangle  $1 \times 4\frac{7}{8}"$  (4,5 x 12,75) miter left corner.

**Middle block:** (16 x)

Size:  $6\frac{1}{4} \times 6\frac{1}{4}"$  (16 x 16 cm)




Square **4**  $5\frac{1}{2} \times 5\frac{1}{2}"$  (14 x 14 cm)

Trapezoid **5** from rectangle  $1\frac{3}{4} \times 7\frac{1}{8}"$  (5 x 18,5) miter right corner.

Trapezoid **6** from rectangle  $1\frac{3}{4} \times 7\frac{1}{8}"$  (5 x 18,5) miter left corner.

**Large block:** (10 x)

Size:  $8\frac{1}{2} \times 8\frac{1}{2}"$  (21,75 x 21,75 cm)



Square **7**  $6\frac{3}{4} \times 6\frac{3}{4}"$  (17,75 x 17,75 cm)

Trapezoid **8** from rectangle  $2\frac{3}{4} \times 9\frac{3}{8}"$  (7 x 24,25 cm) miter right corner.

Trapezoid **9** from rectangle  $2\frac{3}{4} \times 9\frac{3}{8}"$  (7 x 24,25 cm) miter left corner.

**Sashing** – cut all strips from fabric **B**:

56 strips <b>a</b>	1 x 4½" (2,75 x 11,75 cm)
8 strips <b>b</b>	1 x 6¾" (2,75 x 17,5 cm)
15 strips <b>c</b>	1 x 8¾" (2,75 x 23,25 cm)
13 strips <b>d</b>	1 x 12" (34,75 cm)
2 strips <b>e</b>	1 x 32" (2,75 x 82 cm)
3 strip <b>f</b>	1 x 18" (2,75 x 46,25 cm)
4 strips <b>g</b>	1 x 27" (2,75 x 69,25)
2 strips <b>h</b>	1 x 40½" (2,75 x 103,75 cm)
2 strips <b>i</b>	1 x 31½" (2,75 x 80,75 cm)

**Backing:**

Rectangle 53 x 66" (135 x 170 cm) in **C**

**Batting:**

Rectangle 53 x 66" (135 x 170 cm)

**Binding:**

5 strips 2" (6,5 cm) x width of the fabric in **N** ➞

**Hanging sleeve:**


Strip 4½ x 48" (11,5 x 123 cm) in **C**

**Making the blocks:**

Sew trapezoids to the squares. Miter corners.

**Assembling quilt top:**

Referring to diagram, sew the 8 sections. Join sections into 2 units. Sew units together.



**Quilting and finishing:**

Layer and baste together the backing, batting and quilt top ➡. Quilt by hand or machine as you'd like ➡. Bind ➡. Add hanging sleeve ➡.
