
## BIRDS ON A WIRE

QUILT SIZE 40x48
BLOCKS SET 5x6
BLOCK SIZE 8 INCHES (8.5 INCHES WITH SEAM ALLOWANCES)




## QUILT NOTES:

- 1. Fussy cut bird fabric to 8.5 inches.
- 2. The alternate blocks are pieced from strips that are cut 2.5 inches and then sub cut as explained below.

## PIECING BLOCKS

- 1. Sew the multicolored 4 patches together first you need 15 and I'd use some short strip sets.
- 2. Take your 2.5 inch white strips and sub cut them into 2.5 x 4.5 inches
- 3. Sub cut remaining strips into 2.5 inch squares not counting the 4 patches; you'll need 60 squares (4 squares x 15 blocks). Assemble the blocks as shown below. You'll sew two squares on either side of a background strip for the top and bottom of the block, and then sew a white strip on either side of the 4 patch.
- 4. Finally, sew these three sections together.
- 5. If you press toward the dark all your seams should line up nicely.
- 6. When assembling the top, press all seams toward the focus fabric.



Your finished block should measure 8 inches (8.5 with seam allowances)
