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
# Sew with Jo-Ann

#### **SUPPLIES & TOOLS:**

- 2 coordinating fat quarters (brown & green)
- 1 spool 1/4" brown gross grain ribbon
- Polyester stuffing
- Template plastic
- Fine Sharpie pen
- Craft scissors
- Fabric scissors
- Basic sewing supplies
- Sewing machine

#### **DIRECTIONS:**

- 1. Enlarge or reduce pattern to desired size. Trace pattern on template plastic and cut out.
- 2. Use pattern template for bottom and cut 6 pieces.
- 3. With 1/4" seam allowance stitch side seams of three pieces together, leaving 1/4" open at point. Repeat.
- 4. Sew 2 halves together, leaving a 2" opening for turning.
- 5. Using pattern template for top, cut 3 pieces.
- 6. Sew sides, leaving 1/4" open at point.
- 7. Gather outer edge of top and fit right sides together into bottom.
- 8. Stitch.
- 9. Turn, stuff and stitch opening.
- 10. Fold a 6" pc of ribbon in half and knot at cut ends.
- 11. Stitch knot to center of top.
