### Size

each wing about 27.6 inch (70 cm) wide about.21 inch (53 cm) high

#### Material

- 1 skein sock yarn 459 yds / 3,5 oz (420 m / 100g), Original Yarn Regia Hand-dye Effect
- 1 circular needle 5 mm, US size 8
- 1 crochet hook 5 mm, US size 8
- 1 stitch marker

### <u>Instructions</u>

cast on 4 sts

purl one row, continue as follows

- 1. row \*k1, M1 \* repeat from \* to \* until 1 st left, k1
- 2.row purl.
- 3.row ike row 1
- 4.row purl
- 5.row \*k1 M1\* repeat from \* to \* once, k4, M1, place marker, k1 (center st), M1., k4, M1, k1\*. repeat from \* to \* once
- 6.row purl
- 7.row \*k1 M1\* repeat from \* to \* once , knit to the marker..M1,slip marker, k1 M1, knit until 2 sts left, \* M1 k1\*. \* repeat from \* to \* once
- 8.row purl

Repeat rows 8 and 9 until you have 211 sts. Remove marker on last row.

Only odd rows are shown in charts, all even rows are purled.

Start with chart A then follow chart B and C

Cast off loosley

## **Finishing**

Handwash gently with liitle bit of mild soap. In order to ease the wetness roll in a clean towel.

Pin it to desired measurement

let dry



#### **Abbreviations**

fM (feste Masche) single crochet

k knit

ktbl knit through the backloop LfM (Luftmasche) chain

M1 make one: lift the strand between the two needles and knit it through the

backloop

p purl

psso pass the slipes stitch(es) over

r row slip st(s) stitch (es) tog together

WH (Wiederholen) pattern repeat

yo yarn over

#### Legende

- D k1
- no stitch
- 8 M1
- **0** yo
- 000 3 yarn over, on wrong side row work p1 k1 p1,
- 2 yarn over, on wrong side row work p1 k1
- / k2tog
- sl1. K1 psso
- ↑ sl1, k2tog, psso
- ↑ k3 tog
- sl1 knitwise, sl 1 knitwise, k1, psso
- k in front and back of the same st (make 2 sts from 1 st)
- K2tog and keep them on the lefthand needle, slip the first st of them on righthand needle, k the remaining st with the next st together (make 2 sts from 3 sts)
- bead, pull the st with a crochet hook through the bead and knit this sts
- nupp, work very loosley in the same st: k1, yo,k1, yo, k1. On wrong siderow purl this 5 sts together
- H single crochet and 1 chain
- A single crochet and 3 chains
