

Fingerless Gloves Stripes & Tulips





sts back to the left needle again* – repeat from* until all sts have been bound off. Pull the yarn tail through the remaining 3 sts, secure and weave in ends).

Thumb: take up the formerly held 20 thumb sts again, cast on 4 new sts over the thumb opening = 24 sts. Follow **Chart Right Thumb** for Rounds 73 through 79, then bind off the regular way or, if you want, again using the **I-cord bind-off** method.

Work the second fingerless mitt following **Left Chart** and **Chart Left Thumb**.

Carefully hide all ends.

Materials: fingering weight yarn, such as Trekking XXL (plant dyed) by Atelier Zitron (article 2010, yardage 420m [460 yds]/100g [3.5 oz]), 20 g [0.7 oz] ea in colors Olive and Lilac, 10 g [0.35 oz] ea in colors Petrol and Pale Blue and 5 g [0.175 oz] in Berry, Orange and Red.

Tools: DPN set 2.5 mm [US1.5].

Size: One-Size Ladies. Finished size can be easily adjusted by omitting or adding vertical stripes. Gauge per (10 x 10 cm [4 x 4 in]): in stockinette stitch: 33 sts x 42 rows, in colorwork pattern : 35 sts x 36 rows

Directions

Mitt: Using DPN set 2.5 mm [US1.5] and color olive, cast on 64 sts = 16 sts per needle and join into round. Continue working from **Right Chart**. Work until Round 46 has been completed. Work thumb increases as shown in chart, then transfer the 20 thumb stitches (red line) to a piece of waste yarn and cast on 2 new sts to bridge the held thumb sts = 66 sts. In Rounds 75 and 76, decrease 1 st each from the 2 increased sts = 64 sts. After Round 93, bind off, either the regular way or, if you want, using the

I-cord bind-off method: (*k2, k2tog, then slip these 3
