Crochet Pattern

Start Here...

- · Please, read the whole pattern through properly so you have a good overview.
- · This amigurumi is made up of the following parts:
 - · 1 Head with 2 Ears
 - · 2 Arms
 - · 1 Body
 - · 1 Circus Ball
 - · Optional: 1 Little Bow or 1 Little Star.
- · Measurements: 10.2 inches (26 cm).

Materials

- · 3 mm crochet hook.
- · 4 mm crochet hook.
- · Worsted Weight Yarn. 7 colors: Red, Orange, Fuchsia, Gold, Green, Turquoise and Gray.
- · DK Yarn. 1 color: White.
- · Cushion Stuffing.
- · 2 Amigurumi Safety Eyes 21mm.
- · Some pink sequins.
- · Scissors & needle.

Notes

- · The ch and sl st are not included in the stitch count of each round.
- · Note that the orientation of all parts of the pattern are set looking at the project from the front.



Crochet Pattern

Head:

· This part is worked continuously. You should use a stitch marker. With Gray yarn create a Magic Ring with 6 sc.

1 round: * 1 sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc * repeat 2 more times (9 sts).
                   1 sc in each sc (9 sts).
       3 round: 2 sc in next 2 sc, 1 sc in next 7 sc (11 sts).
  4 to 5 round: 1 sc in each sc (11 sts, 2 rounds in total).

6 round: 1 sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc * repeat one more time, 1 sc in next 7 sc (13 sts).
       7 round: 1 sc in each sc (13 sts).
       8 round:
                   * 1 sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc * repeat one more time, 1 sc in next 7 sc (15 sts).
       9 round: 1 sc in each sc (15 sts).
      10 round:
                  * 1 sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc * repeat one more time, 1 sc in next 7 sc (17 sts).
      11 round: 1 sc in each sc (17 sts).
      12 round:
                   * 1 sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc * repeat one more time, 1 sc in next 7 sc (19 sts).
      13 round: 1 sc in each sc (19 sts).
      14 round: 1 sc in next 4 sc, * 1 sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc * repeat 3 more times, 1 sc in next 7 sc (23 sts).
      15 round: 1 sc in next 4 sc, * 1 sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc * repeat 3 more times, 1 sc in next 7 sc (27 sts).
      16 round: 1 sc in next 4 sc, * 1 sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc * repeat 3 more times, 1 sc in next 7 sc (31 sts).
      17 round: 1 sc in next 4 sc, * 1 sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc * repeat 3 more times, 1 sc in next 7 sc (35 sts).
      18 round: 1 sc in next 4 sc, * 1 sc in next 5 sc, 2 sc in next sc * repeat 3 more times, 1 sc in next 7 sc (39 sts).
      19 round: 1 sc in next 4 sc, * 1 sc in next 6 sc, 2 sc in next sc * repeat 3 more times, 1 sc in next 7 sc (43 sts).
      20 round: 1 sc in next 4 sc, * 1 sc in next 7 sc, 2 sc in next sc * repeat 3 more times, 1 sc in next 7 sc (47 sts).
      21 round: 1 sc in next 4 sc, * 1 sc in next 8 sc, 2 sc in next sc * repeat 3 more times, 1 sc in next 7 sc (51 sts).
      22 round: 1 sc in next 4 sc, * 1 sc in next 9 sc, 2 sc in next sc * repeat 3 more times, 1 sc in next 7 sc (55 sts).
23 to 31 round: 1 sc in each sc (55 sts, 9 rounds in total).
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· Now you must do and sew the eyes. To learn how to make them, please see the explanation on page 4.

32 round: * 1 sc in next 9 sc, sc2tog * repeat 4 more times (50 sts).

33 to 34 round: 1 sc in each sc (50 sts, 2 rounds in total).

35 round: * 1 sc in next 8 sc, sc2tog * repeat 4 more times (45 sts).

36 round: 1 sc in each sc (45 sts).

37 round: * 1 sc in next 7 sc, sc2tog * repeat 4 more times (40 sts).

38 round: 1 sc in each sc (40 sts).

· Now you must do and sew the ears. To learn how to make them, please see the explanation on page 4 and 5.

* 1 sc in next 6 sc, sc2tog * repeat 4 more times (35 sts).
40 round:
1 sc in each sc (35 sts).

* 1 sc in next 5 sc, sc2tog * repeat 4 more times (30 sts).
1 sc in each sc (30 sts).
1 sc in each sc (30 sts).

* 1 sc in next 4 sc, sc2tog * repeat 4 more times (25 sts).
44 round:
1 sc in next 3 sc, sc2tog * repeat 4 more times (20 sts).
1 sc in next 2 sc, sc2tog * repeat 4 more times (15 sts).
1 sc in next 2 sc, sc2tog * repeat 4 more times (10 sts).
1 sc in next sc, sc2tog * repeat 4 more times (10 sts).
1 sc2tog * repeat 4 more times (5 sts).
```

· Stuff the Head. Now using your yarn needle, weave the yarn tail through each remaining stitch and pull it tight to close. Fasten off.

Head: Only for Rainbow version

- · Make the following changes for the rainbow version:
- · Each round that you make a color change, you must join with sl st and start the next round with 1 ch.
- · Start the head with Red yarn.
- · On Round 2 change to Orange yarn.
- · On Round 4 change to Fuchsia yarn.
- · On Round 6 change to Yellow yarn.
- · On Round 8 change to Green yarn.
- · On Round 10 change to Turquoise yarn.
- · On Round 12 change to Gray yarn.



Crochet Pattern

Eye: (x2)

 \cdot With DK White yarn and 3mm crochet hook create a Magic Ring with 6 sc.

1 round: 2 sc in next 2 sc, 2 ch, skip next sc, 2 sc in next 3 sc (10 sts).

* 1 sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc * repeat one more time, 3 sc in next 2 ch space, * 1 sc in next sc, 2 sc 2 round:

in next sc * repeat 2 more times (18 sts). Join with sl st in frist sc of this round. Fasten off and leave a

long tail for sewing that piece later.

· Put the eyes on the head. Place them centered, between rounds 15 and 20 of the head, with the 2 ch space of each eye facing the inside of the head and sew their outer edges. For your reference these parts have a distance of 2 sts between them. Fasten off.

· Now put the amigurumi safety eyes in 2 ch space of each "white eye".

Ear: (x2)

· These parts are worked continuously. You should use a stitch marker. With Gray yarn create a Magic Ring with 6 sc.

1 round: 2 sc in each sc (12 sts).

2 round: * 1 sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc * repeat 5 more times (18 sts).

3 round: * 1 sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc * repeat 5 more times (24 sts).

4 round: 1 sc in each sc (24 sts).

5 round: * 1 sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc * repeat 5 more times (30 sts).

6 round: 1 sc in each sc (30 sts).

7 round: * 1 sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc * repeat 5 more times (36 sts).

8 to 12 round: 1 sc in each sc (36 sts, 5 rounds in total).
13 round: * 1 sc in next 10 sc, sc2tog * repeat 2 more times (33 sts).

14 round: 1 sc in each sc (33 sts).

15 round: *1 sc in next 9 sc, sc2tog * repeat 2 more times (30 sts). Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing that

piece later.


· Flatten the open edges of each ear and sew them closed. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.





· Now sew the ears on the head. Place them centered, between rounds 32 and 33 of the head. For your reference the ears have a distance of 15 sts between them. Fasten off.







Crochet Pattern

Ear: Only for Rainbow version

- · Make one ear with the following changes:
- · Each round that you make a color change, you must join with sl st and start the next round with 1 ch.
- · Start the ear with Red yarn.
- · On Round 3 change to Orange yarn.
- · On Round 5 change to Fuchsia yarn.
- · On Round 7 change to Yellow yarn.
- · On Round 9 change to Green yarn.
- · On Round 11 change to Turquoise yarn.
- · On Round 13 change to Gray yarn.

Hair:

- · To make the Hair, cut a piece of Gray yarn, 1 inch (2.54 cm) in length. Insert the hook through one stitch on top of the head, yarn over, draw yarn through the stitch (you've done a loop), yarn over again (with both strands) and pull through the loop.
- · Repeat this process to make another hair in the same stitch and 2 new hairs in the stitch next to the first one.
- · Now insert a needle into each yarn and open their strands.
- · Finally, cut the hair to the desired length.

Arm: (x2)

· This part is worked continuously. You should use a stitch marker. With Gray yarn create a Magic Ring with 6 sc.

  4 to 7 round: 1 sc in each sc (24 sts, 4 rounds in total).
       8 round: * 1 sc in next 10 sc, sc2tog * repeat one more time (22 sts).
 9 to 10 round: 1 sc in each sc (22 sts, 2 rounds in total).
     11 round: * 1 sc in next 9 sc, sc2tog * repeat one more time (20 sts).
12 to 13 round: 1 sc in each sc (20 sts, 2 rounds in total).
     14 round: * 1 sc in next 8 sc, sc2tog * repeat one more time (18 sts).
15 to 16 round: 1 sc in each sc (18 sts, 2 rounds in total).
     17 round: * 1 sc in next 7 sc, sc2tog * repeat one more time (16 sts).
18 to 19 round: 1 sc in each sc (16 sts, 2 rounds in total).
     20 round: * 1 sc in next 6 sc, sc2tog * repeat one more time (14 sts).
21 to 22 round: 1 sc in each sc (14 sts, 2 rounds in total).
     23 round: * 1 sc in next 5 sc, sc2tog * repeat one more time (12 sts).
24 to 25 round: 1 sc in each sc (12 sts, 2 rounds in total).
```

· Stuff the arms. Then flatten the open edges of each arm and sew them closed. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Arm: Only for Rainbow version

- · Make one arm with the following changes:
- · Each round that you make a color change, you must join with sl st and start the next round with 1 ch.
- · Start the arm with Red yarn.
- · On Round 3 change to Orange yarn.
- · On Round 5 change to Fuchsia yarn.
- · On Round 7 change to Yellow yarn.
- · On Round 9 change to Green yarn.
- · On Round 11 change to Turquoise yarn.
- · On Round 13 change to Gray yarn.



Crochet Pattern

Leg: (x2)

- · You must stuff these parts little by little as you crochet them, making the process easier.
- · This part is worked continuously. You should use a stitch marker. With Gray yarn create a Magic Ring with 6 sc.

1 round: 2 sc in each sc (12 sts).

2 round: * 1 sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc * repeat 5 more times (18 sts).

3 round: * 1 sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc * repeat 5 more times. Join with sl st in first sc of this round (24

sts).

4 round: Work with the back loop only this round. 1 ch (do not count as first sc), 1 sc in next 24 sc (24 sts).

5 round: 1 sc in each sc (24 sts).

6 round: * 1 sc in next 7 sc, 2 sc in next sc * repeat 2 more times (27 sts).

7 round: 1 sc in each sc (27 sts). Fasten off, leaving a long tail on first leg. Don't fasten off the second leg.

Joining the 2 Legs and Starting the Body:

· Take the second leg and do:

8 round: 1 sc in next 5 sc (figure 1), (take the first leg) 1 sc in the 22th sc of first leg (figure 2 & 3), 1 sc in next

26 sc of first leg (figure 4), 1 sc in next 22 sc of second leg (figure 5 & 6) (54 sts).

9 to 10 round: 1 sc in each sc (figure 7 & 8) (54 sts, 2 rounds in total).

· Now you must take the yarn of the first leg with your needle, and do several stitches at the joint between the first and second leg. Fasten off. (figure 9 & 10)

11 round: * 1 sc in next 8 sc, 2 sc in next sc * repeat 5 more times (60 sts).

12 to 17 round: 1 sc in each sc (60 sts. 6 rounds in total).

18 round: * 1 sc in next 8 sc, sc2tog * repeat 5 more times (54 sts).

19 to 21 round: 1 sc in each sc (54 sts, 3 rounds in total).

22 round: * 1 sc in next 7 sc, sc2tog * repeat 5 more times (48 sts).

23 to 24 round: 1 sc in each sc (48 sts, 2 rounds in total).

25 round: * 1 sc in next 6 sc, sc2tog * repeat 5 more times (42 sts).

26 to 27 round: 1 sc in each sc (42 sts, 2 rounds in total).

28 round: * 1 sc in next 5 sc, sc2tog * repeat 5 more times (36 sts).

29 to 32 round: 1 sc in each sc (36 sts, 4 rounds in total).

33 round: * 1 sc in next 4 sc, sc2tog * repeat 5 more times (30 sts).

34 round: * 1 sc in next 1 sc, sc2tog, 1 sc in next 2 sc * repeat 5 more times (24 sts). Fasten off and leave a

long tail for sewing that piece later (figure 11 & 12).

Body: Only for Girl version

- · Make the following changes for the girl version:
- · On Round 16 change to Fuchsia yarn.
- · Work with the back loop only the Round 17.
- · On Round 18 change to Gray yarn.

Skirt: Only for Girl version

· Work this part continuously. You should use a stitch marker.

1 round: Attach a new Fuchsia yarn on the back of the Body, on round 17. Work with the front loop only this

round. 1 sc in each sc (60 sts).

2 to 3 round: 1 sc in each sc (60 sts, 2 rounds in total).

4 round: 2 sc in each sc (120 sts).

5 round: 2 sc in each sc (240 sts). Fasten off.

· Optionally you can sew some sequins randomly on the skirt.





Crochet Pattern

Tail:

· With Gray yarn do 6 ch.

1 round: 1 sl st in 2nd ch from hook, 1 sl st in next 4 ch (5 sts). Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing that piece later.

- · To finish the Tail, cut a piece of Gray yarn, 1 inch (2.54 cm) in length. Insert the hook through the last ch, yarn over, draw yarn through the stitch (you've done a loop), yarn over again (with both strands) and pull through the loop.
- · Repeat this process to make more hairs. I made 3 in total.
- · Finally, cut the hair to the desired length.
- · Now insert a needle into each yarn and open their strands.
- · Sew the Tail on the back of the body. Place it centered on between rounds 14 and 15. Fasten off.

Little Star: Only for Rainbow version

· This part is worked continuously. You should use a stitch marker. With Gold yarn create a Magic Ring with 10 sc. Join with sl st in first sc of Magic Ring.

1 round: 5 ch, 1 sc in 3rd ch from hook, 1 hdc in next ch, 1 dc in next ch, skip next sc, * 1 sl st in next sc, 5 ch, 1 sc in 3rd ch from hook, 1 hdc in next ch, 1 dc in next ch, skip next sc * repeat 3 more times (15 sts). Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing that piece later.

· Sew the Little Star on the body. Place it a little to the left, between rounds 13 and 23. Fasten off.

Little Bow: Only for Girl version

- · With Fuchsia yarn create a Magic Ring with 3 ch, 2 dc, 3 ch, 1 sl st, 3 ch, 2 dc, 3 ch. Join with sl st.
- · Sew the Little Bow on top of the head. Place it in front of hairs. Fasten off.

Finishing the Elephant Amigurumi:

- · Sew the head on the body.
- · With Gray yarn, sew the arms on both sides of the body, right and left, on round 33.
- · Fasten off all yarns.



Crochet Pattern

Circus Ball

· You will create the circus ball with 6 granny squares.

Ball Granny Square: (x6)

· With Main color yarn create a Magic Ring with 3 ch (count as first dc), 2 dc, 1 ch, * 3 dc, 1 ch * repeat 2 more times. Join with sl st on top ch. Fasten off.

1 round: Attach a new Secondary yarn in first ch space and do 3 ch (count as first dc) and 2 dc, 1 ch, 3 dc in the

same ch space, skip next 3 dc, * 3 dc, 1 ch and 3 dc in next ch space, skip next 3 dc * repeat 2 more

times. Join with sl st in top ch (24 sts). Fasten off.

2 round: Attach a new White yarn in first ch space and do 3 ch (count as first dc) and 2 dc, 1 ch, 3 dc in the same

ch space, skip next 3 dc, 3 dc in next space, skip next 3 dc, * 3 dc, 1 ch and 3 dc in next ch space, skip next 3 dc, 3 dc in next space, skip next 3 dc * repeat 2 more times. Join with sl st in top ch (36 sts).

Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing that piece later.

Make 6 granny squares with the following color guide:


- 1. Main Color: Gold, Secondary color: Fuchsia.
- 2. Main Color: Fuchsia, Secondary color: Gold.
- 3. Main Color: Orange, Secondary color: Red.
- 4. Main Color: Red, Secondary color: Orange.
- **5.** Main Color: Tuquoise, Secondary color: Green.
- 6. Main Color: Green, Secondary color: Turquoise.
- · Place 2 squares together and sew the edges. Repeat this process until you have 4 squares sewn from right to left.
- · Now sew the edge of the first square with the edge of the last square.
- · Then place the two remaining squares, up and down, forming a cube, and sew their edges.
- · Remember that you must stuff the ball before closing completely.
- · Although the basic shape that you have created is a cube, when you stuff it enough, a ball will appear.

















Each round/row has a different color.






Ball Granny Square (x6)




Little Star
