GOOD WITCH CROCHET PATTERN



Used material: purple (1 ball), light purple (just a little), white (just a little), (we used Czech production wool with parameter 50g/152 m -name: Elian Nicky, VSV Pilníkov, it is 100 % acryl)

Beige (1 ball) (Glorie - Vlnap)

Light purple (1 ball) (Limone- 100% cotton, 50g/125m, or Camilla - the same parameters) - to make hair

Toy stuffing material

Thread to sew the parts together

Hook according to used material

Small buttons for decoration of patches on dress and hat

Safety eyes (clear with black center, size: 12 mm)

Short piece of round wooden stick and some e.g. birch tree sticks to make the broom

We work with single crochet (SC), use slip stitch (Sl St) to join the rows. Start each row with two chain stitches (Ch) – (do not count the chain stitches into the total count of stitches) – and finish each row with slip stitch

Terminology:

SC = single crochet

DC = double crochet

TC = triple crochet (twice cast on double crochet)

Ch = chain

DEC = decrease

SI St = slip stitch

Body: beige color

Start with the loop

1st row – crochet 2 Ch (as each beginning) and 12 SC into the loop

 2^{nd} row – crochet one SC into the first SC of the first row, crochet 2 SC into the second SC, repeat 6x =18 SC in total

 3^{rd} row – one SC into the first two SC, 2 SC into the third SC, repeat 6x =24 SC in total

4th row – one SC into the first three SC, 2 SC into the fourth SC, repeat 6x =30 SC in total

5th row – one SC into the first four SC, 2 SC into the fifth SC, repeat 6x =36 SC in total



- 6th row one SC into the first five SC, 2 SC into the sixth SC, repeat 6x =42 SC in total
- 7th row one SC into the first six SC, 2 SC into the seventh SC, repeat 6x =48 SC in total
- 8th row one SC into the first seven SC of the last row, 2 SC into the eighth SC, repeat 6x =54 SC in total
- 9th row one SC into the first eight SC of the last row, 2 SC into the ninth SC, repeat 6x =60 SC in total
- 10^{th} row one SC into the first nine SC of the last row, 2 SC into the tenth SC, repeat 6x =66 SC in total
- 11th row crochet one SC into each SC of the last row = 66 SC in total
- 12th 20th row the same as the 11th row (9 rows each 66 SC in total)
- 21st row one SC into the first nine SC, DEC (crochet together the 10th and 11th or skip 10th), repeat 6x =60 SC in total
- 22nd row crochet one SC into each SC of the last row = 60 SC in total
- 23rd and 24th row –the same as the 22nd row (2 rows each 60 SC in total)
- 25^{th} row one SC into the first eight SC, DEC (crochet together the 9^{th} and 10^{th} or skip 9^{th}), repeat 6x =54 SC in total
- 26th row crochet one SC into each SC of the last row = 54 SC in total
- 27th and 28th row the same as the 26th row (2 rows each 54 SC in total)
- 29th row one SC into the first seven SC, DEC (crochet together the 8th and 9th or skip 8th), repeat 6x =48 SC in total
- 30th row crochet one SC into each SC of the last row = 48 SC in total
- 31st and 32nd row –the same as the 30th row (2 rows each 48 SC in total)
- 33rd row one SC into the first six SC, DEC (crochet together the 7th and 8th or skip 7th), repeat 6x =42 SC in total
- 34th row crochet one SC into each SC of the last row = 42 SC in total
- 35th row –the same as the 34th row (42 SC in total)
- 36^{th} row one SC into the first five SC, DEC (crochet together the 6^{th} and 7^{th} or skip 6^{th}), repeat 6x = 36 SC in total
- 37th row crochet one SC into each SC of the last row = 36 SC in total
- 38th row the same as the 37th row (36 SC in total)
- 39^{th} row one SC into the first four SC, DEC (crochet together the 5^{th} and 6^{th} or skip 5^{th}), repeat 6x = 30 SC in total
- 40^{th} row one SC into the first three SC, DEC (crochet together the 4^{th} and 5^{th} or skip 4^{th}), repeat 6x = 24 SC in total

Interrupt the work and fill in the body with toy stuffing, than continue work as follows:

- 41^{st} row one SC into the first two SC, DEC (crochet together the 3^{rd} and 4^{th} or skip 3^{rd}), repeat 6x =18 SC in total
- 42^{nd} row one SC into the first SC, DEC (crochet together the 2^{nd} and 3^{rd} or skip 2^{nd}), repeat 6x = 12 SC in total
- 43rd row DEC (crochet together the 1st and 2nd or skip 1st), repeat 6x =6 SC in total
- 44^{th} row DEC (crochet together the 1^{st} and 2^{nd} or skip 1^{st}), repeat 3x = 3 SC in total, fasten off

Head: Beige color

Start with the loop

- 1st row crochet 2 Ch (as each beginning) and 12 SC into the loop.
- 2^{nd} row crochet one SC into the first SC of the first row, crochet 2 SC into the second SC, repeat 6x =18 SC in total



- 3rd row one SC into the first two SC of the last row, 2 SC into the third SC, repeat 6x =24 SC in total
- 4th row one SC into the first three SC of the last row, 2 SC into the fourth SC, repeat 6x =30 SC in total
- 5th row one SC into the first four SC of the last row, 2 SC into the fifth SC, repeat 6x =36 SC in total
- 6th row one SC into the first five SC of the last row, 2 SC into the sixth SC, repeat 6x =42 SC in total
- 7th row one SC into the first six SC of the last row, 2 SC into the seventh SC, repeat 6x =48 SC in total
- 8th row one SC into the first seven SC of the last row, 2 SC into the eighth SC, repeat 6x =54 SC in total
- 9th row one SC into the first eight SC of the last row, 2 SC into the ninth SC, repeat 6x =60 SC in total
- 10th row crochet one SC into each SC of the last row = 60 SC in total
- 11th to 21st row the same as 10th row (11 rows each 60 in total)
- 22^{nd} row one SC into the first eight SC, DEC (crochet together the 9^{th} and 10^{th} or skip 9^{th}), repeat 6x = 54 SC in total
- 23^{rd} row one SC into the first seven SC, DEC (crochet together the 8^{th} and 9^{th} or skip 8^{th}), repeat 6x = 48 SC in total
- 24th row one SC into the first six SC, DEC (crochet together the 7th and 8th or skip 7th), repeat 6x =42 SC in total
- 25^{th} row one SC into the first five SC, DEC (crochet together the 6^{th} and 7^{th} or skip 6^{th}), repeat 6x = 36 SC in total
- 26^{th} row one SC into the first four SC, DEC (crochet together the 5^{th} and 6^{th} or skip 5^{th}), repeat 6x = 30 SC in total
- 27^{th} row one SC into the first three SC, DEC (crochet together the 4^{th} and 5^{th} or skip 4^{th}), repeat 6x = 24 SC in total

Interrupt the work, put on the safety eyes and then fill the head in with the toy stuffing (if you are not using the safety eyes, fill in the head first and than embroider the eyes or sew on some beads for eyes); than continue work as follows:

- 28^{th} row one SC into the first two SC, DEC (crochet together the 3^{rd} and 4^{th} or skip 3^{rd}), repeat 6x = 18 SC in total
- 29^{th} row one SC into the first SC, DEC (crochet together the 2^{nd} and 3^{rd} or skip 2^{nd}), repeat 6x =12 SC in total
- 30th row DEC (crochet together the 1st and 2nd or skip 1st), repeat 6x =6 SC in total
- 31^{st} row DEC (crochet together the 1^{st} and 2^{nd} or skip 1^{st}), repeat 3x = 3 SC in total, fasten off

Nose: beige color

Start with the loop

- 1st row crochet 2 Ch (as each beginning) and 5 SC into the loop
- 2nd row crochet one SC into each SC of the first row = 5 SC in total
- 3rd to 5th row the same as the 2nd row (3 rows each 5 SC in total)
- 6th row crochet one SC into the first SC, crochet 2 SC into the second SC, repeat 2x, 1 Sc into the last one = 7 SC in total, fasten off

Ears (make 2): beige color

Start with the loop

- 1st row crochet 2 Ch (as each beginning) and 6 SC into the loop
- 2nd row crochet two SC into each SC of the first row = 12 SC in total
- 3rd row crochet one SC into each SC of the last row = 12 SC in total, fasten off






Legs (make 2): purple, light purple and white color

Start with 7 + 2 Ch.

 1^{st} row – crochet according the scheme on right (crochet 9 Ch, starting from the third Ch from the hook, crochet 6 SC – one into each Ch, than three into the last one, turn the work and crochet from the other side one SC into each Ch (5 times), than 2 SC into the last Ch = 16 SC in total

 2^{nd} row – crochet one SC into each of the first seven SC of the first row. Make 3 SC into the 8^{th} SC, than crochet one SC into each of the next 7 SC and 3 SC into the last SC = 20 SC in total







3rd row – crochet 2 SC into the first SC of the last row, than one SC into each of next 5 SC, crochet 2 SC into each of following 5 SC, than again one SC into each of next 5 SC and 2 SC into each of last 4 SC = 30 SC in total

4th row – in this row crochet into back loop of each SC only: crochet one SC into each SC of last row = 30 SC in total

5th row – crochet one SC into each SC of last row = 30 SC in total

6th row – the same as the 5th row (30 SC in total)

 7^{th} row – crochet 1 SC into first five SC, *DEC – crochet together the 6^{th} and 7^{th} SC - or skip 6^{th} , than crochet 1 SC into the next SC.*, repeat between* * 4 more times (so you make it 5 times in total), SC one into each of remaining ten SC = 25 SC in total

8th row – crochet 1 SC into first three SC, *DEC – crochet together the 4th and 5th SC - or skip 4th, than crochet 1 SC into the next SC.*, repeat between* * 4 more times (so you make it 5 times in total), SC one into each of remaining seven SC = 20 SC in total

9th row – crochet 1 SC into first SC, *DEC – crochet together the 2nd and 3rd SC - or skip 2nd, than crochet 1 SC into the next SC.*, repeat between* * 4 more times (so you make it 5 times in total), SC one into each of remaining four SC = 15 SC in total

10th row – *DEC – crochet together the 1st and 2nd SC - or skip 1st, than crochet 1 SC into the next SC.*, repeat between* * 4 more times (so you make it 5 times in total) = 10 SC in total

Interrupt the work and fill in the leg with toy stuffing, than continue work as follows:

11th row – crochet one SC into each SC of the tenth row = 10 SC in total

12th and 13th row – the same as 11th row (2 rows, 10 SC in total in each row)

14th row – change the color from darker purple to white and continue as follows: crochet one SC into each SC of the last row = 10 SC in total

15th row – the same as 14th row (10 SC in total)

16th row – change the color from white to light purple and continue as follows: crochet one SC into each SC of the last row = 10 SC in total

17th row – the same as 16th row (10 SC in total)

18th row – change the color from light purple to white and continue as follows: crochet one SC into each SC of the last row = 10 SC in total

19th row – the same as 18th row (10 SC in total)

20th row – change the color from white to light purple and continue as follows: crochet one SC into each SC of the last row = 10 SC in total

21st row – the same as 20th row (10 SC in total)

22nd row – change the color from light purple to white and continue as follows: crochet one SC into each SC of the last row = 10 SC in total

23rd row – the same as 22nd row (10 SC in total)

24th row – change the color from white to light purple and continue as follows: crochet one SC into each SC of the last row = 10 SC in total

25th row – the same as 24th row (10 SC in total)

26th row – change the color from light purple to white and continue as follows: crochet one SC into each SC of the last row = 10 SC in total

27th row – the same as 26th row (10 SC in total)

28th row – change the color from white to light purple and continue as follows: crochet one SC into each SC of the last row = 10 SC in total

29th row – the same as 28th row (10 SC in total)

30th row – change the color from light purple to white and continue as follows: crochet one SC into each SC of the last row = 10 SC in total

- 31st row the same as 30th row (10 SC in total)
- 32nd row change the color from white to light purple and continue as follows: crochet one SC into each SC of the last row = 10 SC in total
- 33rd row the same as 32nd row (10 SC in total), fasten off

Fill in the leg once more so it would be whole stuffed before you sew it on the body

Hands (make 2): beige color

Start with the loop

- 1st row crochet 2 Ch (as each beginning) and 6 SC into the loop
- 2nd row in each SC of the first row crochet two, repeat 6x =12 SC in total
- 3rd row crochet one SC into the first SC, crochet 2 SC into the second SC, repeat 6x =18 SC in total
- 4th row crochet one SC into each SC of the last row = 18 SC in total
- 5^{th} row crochet one SC, DEC (crochet together the 2^{nd} and 3^{rd} SC or skip 2^{nd}), repeat 6 x = 12 SC in total
- 6th row crochet one SC into each SC of the last row = 12 SC in total

Interrupt the work and fill in the hand a little, than continue work as follows:

- 7^{th} row DEC (crochet together the 1^{st} and the 2^{nd} SC or skip 1^{st}), repeat 6x = 6 SC in total,
- 8th row crochet one SC into each SC of the last row = 6 SC in total
- 9th to 33rd row the same as the 8th row (25 rows, 6 SC in total in each row), Fasten off

Hair:

Sew the head on body and using pins mark the line of hair. Than take the needle and light purple yarn (Limone or Camilla) and embroider


the hair in the same way as e.g. at Waldorf dolls. Here you can see some pictures. First sew on hair around the line you marked, than start from the bottom, sew hairs in rows up to the forehead.

You can either sew on each hair separately – one by one or you can make sort of loops which you later cut in halves (here I made each hair little bit different length and after all hairs were sewn on I cut it to haircut and length I wanted.









How to make hair

Hat: purple color

Start with the loop

- 1st row crochet 2 Ch (as each beginning) and 6 SC into the loop
- 2nd row crochet one SC into each SC of the first row = 6 SC in total
- 3rd row the same as the second row (6 SC in total)
- 4th row crochet two SC into each SC of the last row = 12 SC in total
- 5th row crochet one SC into each SC of the last row = 12 SC in total
- 6th row the same as the 5th row (12 SC in total)
- 7^{th} row crochet one SC into the first SC of the last row, crochet 2 SC into the second SC, repeat 6x =18 SC in total
- 8th row crochet one SC into each SC of the last row = 18 SC in total
- 9th row the same as the 8th row (18 SC in total)
- 10th row one SC into the first two SC of the last row, 2 SC into the third SC, repeat 6x =24 SC in total
- 11th row crochet one SC into each SC of the last row = 24 SC in total
- 12th row the same as the 11th row (24 SC in total)
- 13th row one SC into the first three SC of the last row, 2 SC into the fourth SC, repeat 6x =30 SC in total
- 14th row crochet one SC into each SC of the last row = 30 SC in total
- 15th row the same as the 14th row (30 SC in total)
- 16th row one SC into the first four SC of the last row, 2 SC into the fifth SC, repeat 6x =36 SC in total
- 17th row crochet one SC into each SC of the last row = 36 SC in total
- 18th row the same as the 17th row (36 SC in total)
- 19th row one SC into the first five SC of the last row, 2 SC into the sixth SC, repeat 6x =42 SC in total
- 20th row crochet one SC into each SC of the last row = 42 SC in total
- 21st row the same as the 20th row (42 SC in total)
- 22nd row one SC into the first six SC of the last row, 2 SC into the seventh SC, repeat 6x =48 SC in total
- 23rd row crochet one SC into each SC of the last row = 48 SC in total
- 24th row one SC into the first seven SC of the last row, 2 SC into the eighth SC, repeat 6x =54 SC in total
- 25th row crochet one SC into each SC of the last row = 54 SC in total
- 26th row one SC into the first eight SC of the last row, 2 SC into the ninth SC, repeat 6x =60 SC in total
- 27th row crochet one SC into each SC of the last row = 60 SC in total
- 28th row crochet two SC into each SC of the last row = 120 SC in total
- 29th row crochet one SC into each SC of the last row = 120 SC in total
- 30th row the same as the 29th row (120 SC in total), fasten off

Dress: purple color

Start witch chain - 78+1 Ch and join them into a circle

1st row – crochet one SC into each Ch stitch = 78 SC in total





- 2nd row crochet one SC into each SC of the first row = 78 SC in total
- 3rd row the same as the 2nd row (= 78 SC in total)
- 4^{th} row one SC into the first eleven SC, DEC (crochet together the 12^{th} and 13^{th} or skip 12^{th}), repeat 6x = 72 SC in total
- 5th row crochet one SC into each SC of the last row = 72 SC in total
- 6th and 7th row the same as the 5th row (2 rows each with 72 SC in total)
- 8th row one SC into the first ten SC, DEC (crochet together the 11th and 12th or skip 11th), repeat 6x =66 SC in total
- 9th row crochet one SC into each SC of the last row = 66 SC in total
- 10th and 11th row the same as the 9th row (2 rows each with 66 SC in total)
- 12th row one SC into the first nine SC, DEC (crochet together the 10th and 11th or skip 10th), repeat 6x =60 SC in total
- 13th row crochet one SC into each SC of the last row = 60 SC in total
- 14th 22nd row the same as the 13th row (9 rows each with 60 SC in total)
- 23^{rd} row one SC into the first eight SC, DEC (crochet together the 9^{th} and 10^{th} or skip 9^{th}), repeat 6x =54 SC in total
- 24th row crochet one SC into each SC of the last row = 54 SC in total
- 25th to 33rd row the same as the 24th row (9 rows each with 54 SC in total), fasten off

Sleeves to the dress (make 2): purple color

Start witch chain - 30+1 Ch and join them into a circle

- 1st row crochet one SC into each Ch stitch = 30 SC in total
- 2nd row crochet one SC into each SC of the first row = 30 SC in total
- 3rd row the same as the 2nd row (= 30 SC in total)
- 4^{th} row one SC into the first three SC, DEC (crochet together the 4^{th} and 5^{th} or skip 4^{th}), repeat 6x = 24 SC in total
- 5th row crochet one SC into each SC of the last row = 24 SC in total
- 6th row one SC into the first two SC, DEC (crochet together the 3rd and 4th or skip 3rd), repeat 6x =18 SC in total
- 7th row crochet one SC into each SC of the last row = 18 SC in total
- 8th 27th row –the same as the 7th row (20 rows each 18 SC in total), fasten off

Put the dress on the body fist; than put on the sleeves and only after that sew the sleeves to the dress (just sew to the dress the lower side of the sleeve than little bit drape the upper side of the sleeve and attach it directly to the body).

Patches (make 5): light purple color

Start with 5+2 Ch and crochet in straight lines (it means at the end of each row you need to turn it and crochet back in next row)

- 1st row crochet one SC into each Ch = 5 SC in total
- 2nd row crochet one SC into each SC of the first row = 5 SC in total
- 3^{rd} and 4^{th} row the same as the 2^{nd} row = (2 rows each 5 SC in total), fasten off





Patch - heart: light purple color

Start with the loop

1st row – crochet 1 Ch into the loop (as the beginning) and than, 1 SC, 1 DC, 2 TC, 1 DC, 5 SC, 3 DC, 5 SC, 1 DC, 2 TC, 1DC, 1 SC and SI St., fasten off



Sew the patches on dress and hat; if you want you can also use some buttons to decorate the dress and use black thread to embroider stitches around patches. Embroider (or sew on) shoe laces on darker purple part of legs and tie them.

Use round wooden stick and some (birch) sticks to make broom.

You can sit the Witch somewhere or she can "fly" in the space or be hanging on the wall. If the Witch hangs on the wall, do not make her "sit" on the broom, just attach the broom to one hand as if she was holding it. If the Witch is going to "fly" in the space, sew both hands to the broom and attach her bottom to it too so it would look like she was really flying.







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
