Colourful Bunny - crochet pattern

My Crochet Privacy...

<u>Materials</u>

- worsted weight yarn in cream, deep purple, yellow and pink (you can use colours of your choice);
- two black 8mm safety eyes;
- triangle-shape button;
- pink felt and floss;
- crochet hook size 3,5mm (E-4);
- stitch marker (mark last st of each rnd to keep the count right);
- fiberfill for stuffing;
- pins;
- yarn needle for finishing.

<u>Size</u>

Approximately 31cm tall.

<u>Abbreviations</u>

- rnd round;
- ch chain;
- sc single crochet;
- hdc half double crochet;
- dc double crochet;
- st stitch;
- sl st slip stitch;
- BLO back loops only;
- FLO front loops only;
- inc increase;
- dec decrease (note: the invisible decrease method is used in the pattern);
- rep repeat.





Head

In cream yarn Rnd 1: start 6 sc in a magic ring (6) Rnd 2: inc 6 times (12) Rnd 3: *sc in nxt st, inc* rep 6 times (18) Rnd 4: *sc in nxt 2 st, inc* rep 6 times (24) Rnd 5: *sc in nxt 3 st, inc* rep 6 times (30) Rnd 6: *sc in nxt 4 st, inc* rep 6 times (36) Rnd 7: *sc in nxt 5 st, inc* rep 6 times (42) Rnd 8: *sc in nxt 6 st, inc* rep 6 times (48) Rnd 9: *sc in nxt 7 st, inc* rep 6 times (54) Rnd 10: *sc in nxt 8 st, inc* rep 6 times (60) Rnd 11 - 16: work around (60)



Rnd 17: *sc in nxt 8 st, dec* rep 6 times (54) Rnd 18: *sc in nxt 7 st, dec* rep 6 times (48) attach the safety eyes between round 10 and 11 spaced 2 st apart Rnd 19: *sc in nxt 6 st, dec* rep 6 times (42)

Rnd 20: *sc in nxt 5 st, dec* rep 6 times (36)

Rnd 21: *sc in nxt 4 st, dec* rep 6 times (30) Rnd 22: *sc in nxt 3 st, dec* rep 6 times (24) begin stuffing the head with fiberfill Rnd 23: *sc in nxt 2 st, dec* rep 6 times (18) Rnd 24: work around (18) sl st into next st, fasten off, finish stuffing.

Ears (make 2)

In cream yarn Rnd 1: start 6 sc in a magic ring (6) Rnd 2: inc 6 times (12) Rnd 3: *sc in nxt st, inc* rep 6 times (18) Rnd 4 – 8: work around (18) Rnd 9: sc in nxt 8 st, dec, sc in nxt 8 st (17) Rnd 10: work around (17) Rnd 11: sc in nxt 15 st, dec (16) Rnd 12: work around (16) Rnd 13: sc in nxt 7 st, dec, sc in nxt 7 st (15) Rnd 14: work around (15) Rnd 15: sc in nxt 13 st, dec (14) Rnd 16 - 17: work around (14) fasten off and leave a yarn tail for sewing ears to the head; do not stuff the ears with fiberfill. Cut two pieces of pink felt to fit the ear shape and sew each of them to each ear (use pink floss).

Body

Start in cream yarn Rnd 1: start 6 sc in a magic ring (6) Rnd 2: inc 6 times (12) Rnd 3: *sc in nxt st, inc* rep 6 times (18)



Rnd 4: *sc in nxt 2 st, inc* rep 6 times (24) Rnd 5: *sc in nxt 3 st, inc* rep 6 times (30) Rnd 6: *sc in nxt 4 st, inc* rep 6 times (36)

Rnd 7: *sc in nxt 5 st, inc* rep 6 times (42)

Rnd 8 - 9: work around (42)

change to deep purple yarn

Rnd 10: work around (42)

Rnd 11: BLO work around (42)

change to yellow yarn

Rnd 12: work around (42)

change to deep purple yarn

Rnd 13 – 14: work around (42)

change to yellow yarn

Rnd 15: *sc in nxt 12 st, dec* rep 3 times (39)

change to deep purple yarn

Rnd 16: *sc in nxt 11 st, dec* rep 3 times (36) Rnd 17: *sc in nxt 10 st, dec* rep 3 times (33) change to yellow yarn

Rnd 18: *sc in nxt 9 st, dec* rep 3 times (30) change to deep purple yarn

Rnd 19: *sc in nxt 8 st, dec* rep 3 times (27) Rnd 20: *sc in nxt 7 st, dec* rep 3 times (24) change to yellow yarn and begin stuffing the body with fiberfill

Rnd 21: *sc in nxt 6 st, dec* rep 3 times (21) change to deep purple yarn

Rnd 22: *sc in nxt 5 st, dec* rep 3 times (18) Rnd 23: BLO work around (18)

sl st into next st, fasten off and leave a long yarn tail for sewing body to the head, finish stuffing.

Dress (rnd 11 of body)

Using deep purple yarn and holding body upside down start in any st (use FLO) Rnd 1: 3dc in each st around (126 dc) change yarn colour to yellow Rnd 2: work around (126)



Collar (rnd 23 of body)

Using yellow yarn and holding body upside down start in any st (use FLO) Rnd 1: 3hdc in each st around (49 hdc)

<u>Arms (make 2)</u>

Start in cream yarn Rnd 1: start 6 sc in a magic ring (6) Rnd 2: inc 6 times (12) Rnd 3: *sc in nxt st, inc* rep 6 times (18) Rnd 4 – 5: work around (18) Rnd 6: sc in nxt 8 st, dec; sc in nxt 8 st (17) Rnd 7: sc in nxt 15 st, dec (16) Rnd 8: sc in nxt 7 st, dec, sc in nxt 7 st (15)



Rnd 9: sc in nxt 13 st, dec (14) begin stuffing the arm with fiberfill and continue as you work Rnd 10: sc in nxt 6 st, dec; sc in nxt 6 st (13) Rnd 11: sc in nxt 11 st, dec (12) Rnd 12: sc in nxt 5 st, dec, sc in nxt 5 st (11) Rnd 13: sc in nxt 9 st, dec (10) Rnd 14: work around (10) change to deep purple yarn



Rnd 15 – 16 : work around (10) change to yellow yarn Rnd 17: work around (10) change to deep purple yarn Rnd 18 - 19: work around (10) change to yellow yarn Rnd 20: work around (10) change to deep purple yarn Rnd 21: work around (10) stop stuffing arms around 17th rnd, fasten off and leave a long yarn tail for sewing arms to the body.

Legs (make 2)

Start in pink yarn Foundation: ch9 note: stitches are worked around both sides of the foundation chain Rnd 1: 2sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in nxt 6 st, 4sc in last st working on opposite side of chain: sc in nxt 6 st, 2 sc in last st (20) Rnd 2: sc in nxt 7 st, inc in nxt 6 st, sc in nxt 7 st (26) Rnd 3: sc in nxt 10 st, inc in nxt 6 st, sc in nxt 10 st (32) Rnd 4: work around (32) change to cream yarn Rnd 5: work around (32) Rnd 6: sc in nxt 10 st, 6 times dec, sc in nxt 10 st (26) Rnd 7: sc in nxt 7 st, 6 times dec, sc in nxt 7 st (20) Rnd 8: sc in nxt 6 st, 4 times dec, sc in nxt 6 st (16)Rnd 9: *sc in nxt 2 st, dec* rep 4 times (12) begin stuffing the leg with fiberfill and continue as you work Rnd 10 - 25: work around (12) stop stuffing legs around 20th rnd, fasten off and leave a long yarn tail for sewing legs to the body.



Bow

In yellow yarn Row 1: ch 14; turn Row 2: start 2nd chain from hook; sc in nxt 13 st; ch1; turn Row 3 – 4: rep row 2 Row 5: sc in nxt 13 st. fasten off; wrap a middle of the rectangle to create a bow.



Assembling and finishing

When all body parts are ready you may pin them to check how they fit together.

- sew the ears to the head;
- sew the body to the head;
- embroider a nose (use some thin pink yarn) and a mouth (use pictures as a guide);

- sew the arms to the body;
- sew the legs to the body;
- sew the bow to the head;
- sew the button to the body;
- weave all yarn tails inside the body.



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Warning

The amigurumi creation have some small parts, so please be extremely cautious if you decide to give it to a small child. The safety eyes, noses, buttons and other small pieces, if somehow detached during a play time, could be a serious choking hazard!

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
