## Crochet doll Emilie



The height of the doll from head to toe $-22 \mathrm{~cm}\left(8^{\prime \prime}\right)$ !

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If you have any questions, please don't hesitate to ask.

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## Materials:

- Yarn:
-- Gazzal "Baby Cotton" (50g/165m) - (60\% cotton, $40 \%$ acrylic)
-- №3412 - beige for body

- Embroidering of eyes - white, black, violet (or green, or blue at your choice)

- Embroidering of eyebrows - brown

Embroidering of lips - pink

- Polyester filling material
- Crochet hook №l. 4 mm
- 1 mm of copper wire - 40 inches

Buttons -3 pcs small for dress

- Self-adhesive gauze bandage (for edge completion and fixing of the body with arms and legs)



## Abbreviations (US terms):

- MR -- magic ring

- Ch -- chain stitch
- Slip St -- slip stitch
- sc - single crochet
- DC - double crochet
- tr - treble crochet
- hdc - half double crochet

- inc - increase ( 2 sc in the next st)

- dec-- decrease (crochet 2 sc together)

- (...) * - repeat instructions in brackets said number of times
- bl-Sc in back loop only
- $\mathrm{fl}-\mathrm{Sc}$ in front loops only
- = -total number of sts you should have in current round


## Notes:

-     - While you are crocheting in the round, your right side will be on the inside.

- -- Use a stitch marker after each round to keep track of a new row.
-     - Any type of yarn can be used with a suitable hook sizet. The thicker the yarn, the bigger the doll will be.


## 1. Hands (Make 2)

## Starting with the flesh color:

Round 1: 6 sc in MR $=6$
Round 2-19:6 sc=6

## Finish off

## 2. The Legs (Make 2)

## Starting with the flesh color:

Round 1: 6 sc in MR $=6$
Round 2: $(2 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{inc}) * 2$ times $=8$
Round 3-5:8 sc $=8$
Round 6-7: turn, ch 1, 4 sc
Round 8: turn, ch 1, dec * 2 times
Round 9: turn, ch 1, dec

Round 10: by round -4 sc (from the side), $4 \mathrm{sc}, 4 \mathrm{sc}$ (from the side) $=12$
Round 11: 4 sc, dec *2 times, $4 \mathrm{sc} \quad=10$
Gradually add the filler as you crochet the legs.

- Now, we will insert the wire in the leg. Twist one end along the length of the foot in the form of eight. Wrap adhesive tape. See the picture.


Round 13: dec, 6 sc , dec $=8$
Round 14-34: $8 \mathrm{sc}=8$
Finish off.

- Complete the second leg the same way.



## 3. The body

- Change to the white yarn. We will crochet the panties.


## - From the inner side of the right leg, ch 4 and connect to the left leg.

-- I!! Don't forget, we crochet with the wrong the seamy side out!!! If you crochet the face side out, then ch 4 take from the inner side of the left leg hip and connect with the right leg!!!


Round 1:8 sc (on the left leg), 4 sc (on the chain 4 ), 8 sc (on the right leg), 4 sc (on the chain 4) $=24$
-- We should twist the wire frame between each other, winding round with a small piece of adhesive plaster.


-- Next, we crochet 14 sc and put a marker. Here will be the beginning of new round.

> Round $2: 5 \mathrm{sc}$, inc $* 2$ times, $17 \mathrm{sc}=26$
> Round $3: 2 \mathrm{sc}$, inc, 8 sc, inc, $14 \mathrm{sc}=28$

Round 4-5: 28 sc
$=28$
-- Bend the edges of the wire to the sides (this will be hands)

- Change to the flesh-colored yarn.

\text { Round 6-7:28 sc } \quad=28
$$

- Add a piece of wire to the main part (body), the head will be attached here. Fasten it with adhesive plaster.



Round 8: $(\mathrm{dec}, 5 \mathrm{sc})$ * 6 times
$=24$
Round 9: 28 sc $=24$

Round 10: $(\operatorname{dec}, 4 \mathrm{sc}) * 4$ times $\quad=20$
Round 11-17:20 sc $\quad=20$

- Gradually add the filler in the process of crocheting the body.
- Find the center of the back and put the marker to the beginning of the round. Approximately. Count the loops from it.
- We will join arms with body. Make sure the wire is the same length as your crochet arm, bend the edge and wrap it with adhesive tape. See picture below. Do not add filler in the hands!!!

-- Put the crochet hands on the wire

Round 18: $4 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ (crochet together with the hand), $8 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ (crochet together with the hand), $4 \mathrm{sc}=\mathbf{2 0}$

Round 19: (Refer to picture below) 3 sc , dec ( 1 sc from the back + and 1 sc from the hand), 2 sc (by the hand), dec ( 1 sc from the back + and 1 sc from the hand), 6 sc , dec ( 1 sc from the back + and 1 sc from the hand), 2 sc (by the hand), dec ( 1 sc from the back + and 1 sc from the hand), $3 \mathrm{sc}=20$


Round 20:3 sc, dec * 2 times, 6 sc, dec * 2 times, 3 sc

Round 21: $(\mathrm{dec}, 2 \mathrm{sc}) * 4$ times

=12

Round 22: 12 sc
$=12$

Round 23: $(\mathrm{dec}, 1 \mathrm{sc}) * 4$ times

=8
$$

Round 24-25: sc
$=8$


Finish off.


## 4. The Head

Round 2: inc * 6 times $\quad=\mathbf{1 2}$
Round 3: $(1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{inc}) * 6$ times $\quad=18$
Round 4: $(1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{inc}, 1 \mathrm{sc}) * 6$ times $\quad=24$
Round 5: $(3 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{inc}) * 6$ times $\quad=30$
Round 6: $(1 \mathrm{sc}$, inc, 3 sc$) * 6$ times $=36$
Round 7: $(5 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{inc}) * 6$ times $\quad=42$
Round 8: $(1 \mathrm{sc}$, inc, 5 sc$) * 6$ times $\quad=48$

\text { Round 9-19:48sc }=48
$$



Round 20: $(\mathrm{dec}, 6 \mathrm{sc}) * 6$ times $\quad=42$
Round 21: $(\mathrm{dec}, 5 \mathrm{sc}) * 6$ times $\quad=36$

- Let's add the head with the filler

Round 22: $(\mathrm{dec}, 4 \mathrm{sc}) * 6$ times $=30$
Round 23: $(\mathrm{dec}, 3 \mathrm{sc}) * 6$ times $\quad=24$
Round 24: $(\mathrm{dec}, 2 \mathrm{sc}) * 6$ times $\quad=18$

| Round 25: $(\mathrm{dec}, 1 \mathrm{sc}) * 6$ times | $=12$ |
| :--- | :--- |
| Round 26: $(\mathrm{dec}, 1 \mathrm{sc}) * 4$ times | $=8$ |

- The head should be sewed after the face decoration


## The Ears (Make 2)

Round 1:4 sc in MR $=4$

- Pull tightly and finish off, cut the yarn leaving long piece for sewing.
- Sew the ears on the $13-15^{\text {th }}$ round from the start of head. Find the right place and mark it with pins. The distance between ears should be 25 sc .



## 5. Eyes embroidery

## -- Visually divide the face into 4 parts. Find the center and move it down on 1.31 inches $(0.5 \mathrm{~cm})$



Mark a line with the coloured yarn. On this line we will embroider the eyes. (Note the green thread for placment of eyes).


Take a black embroidery thread, split it in half, (three threads in each half).


Let start embroidering. Look at the pictures.

That is all! The eyes are ready. Hide the threads in the head. Let's start to embroider the eyebrows. So, take the brown embroidery thread.


## The nose

--After embroidering the eyes we should start to embroider the nose.


## The MOUTH

-- After embroidering the nose, let's start to embroider the mouth. Insert the needle into the top of the head; output it in one of the corners of the lips. We insert the needle in another corner of the lips. Output it at the base of the neck. Fasten off the thread.


## 6. The Hair

- Cut the yarn of necessary length. I took $(23 \mathrm{~cm}) 9^{\prime \prime}$. We outline the contour by which we will fasten the edge of the hair. First fastening we make from the top of the head. We should fasten them like a fringe to the scarf.

- Attach yarn by the contour of the face. Then, attach from the top to the back of the head in every stitch.




## 7.The Dress

## Yarn - Gazal Baby Cotton 225m/50gm, hook №1.6mm

Using white, ch 31 . Sc in the 6 ch from the hook, to the end, turn.


Round 1:26 sc, turn

## Change to yarn

Round 2:1 $\mathrm{Ch},(2 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{inc}) * 8$ times, 2 sc, turn $=34$


Round 3: $1 \mathrm{Ch}, 34 \mathrm{sc}$, turn $=34$

Round 4: 1 Ch , inc, $4 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{Ch}$ (miss 7 loops), $10 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{Ch}$ (miss 7 sc ), 4 sc , inc, turn $=26$


Round $5: 1 \mathrm{Ch}, 6 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$ in each of the $\mathrm{ch} 2,10 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$ in each of the $\mathrm{ch} 2,6 \mathrm{sc}$, turn $=26$



- So, we should continue to crochet in the round!

Round 11: (1st ruffle) (into the front loop only) $-4 \mathrm{Ch}, 1 \mathrm{tr}, 2 \mathrm{Ch},(2 \mathrm{tr}, 2 \mathrm{Ch})$ ) * in the every sc, Slip St closed



Cut the yarn and fasten it.
Join the yarn to the first loop of the previous round.
Round 12: (into the back loop only) - 3 Ch, ( $6 \mathrm{DC}, \mathrm{inc}$ ) * 6 times, Slip St $=50$


Round 13:1 Ch, 50 sc, Slip St $=50$


Round 14: (2 $2^{\text {nd }}$ ruffle) (into the front loop only) - $4 \mathrm{Ch}, 1 \mathrm{tr}, 2 \mathrm{Ch},(2 \mathrm{tr}, 2 \mathrm{Ch})$ ) * in the every sc, Slip St and fasten off.

Join the yarn to the first loop of the previous round.

Round 15: (into the back loop only): 3 Ch, ( $7 \mathrm{DC}, \mathrm{inc}$ ) ${ }^{*} 6$ times, Slip St $=56$
Round 16: $1 \mathrm{Ch}, 59 \mathrm{sc}$, Slip St $=56$
Round 17: (3 ${ }^{\text {rd }}$ ruffle): $4 \mathrm{Ch}, 1 \mathrm{tr}, 2 \mathrm{Ch},(2 \mathrm{tr}, 2 \mathrm{Ch})$ ) in the every sc, Slip St


Cut the yarn and fasten it.
--Now we should crochet the edge of all ruffles with white yarn.
( $3 \mathrm{Ch}, \mathrm{sc}$ ) * by all round to the end


- Crochet the backside of the dress with sc.

-- Sew the button to the fastener and 2 buttons in the front of the dress for decoration.



## 8. Shoes (Make 2)

-- Hook №1. 6
Foot

## Lilac yarn

-- Crochet Ch $8 . \mathrm{Sc}$ in $2^{\text {nd }}$ chain from hook.
Round 1: $4 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{hdc}, 4 \mathrm{hdc}$ into the one $\mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{hdc}, 3 \mathrm{sc}$, inc $=17$


Round 2: inc, $4 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{hdc}$, (inc from hdc) * 3 times, $2 \mathrm{hdc}, 4 \mathrm{sc}$, inc $=22$

Round 3: (into the back loop only) : 22 sc $=22$

\text { Round 4:22 sc } \quad=\mathbf{2 2}
$$

## Round 5: 6 sc , dec * 6 times, 4 sc

Round 6: 6 sc , dec * 3 times, 4 sc

$=13,+1 \mathrm{sc}$ for replacement the loop to the center



## Change to white yarn

Round 7:3 Ch, $13 \mathrm{DC} \quad=\mathbf{1 3}$


## Cut the yarn and fasten off.

- Ok, so take the white yarn and join it to the $3^{\text {rd }}$ round. Crochet from the last front side of the loop at this round - $(1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{inc})^{*}$ till the end of the round. Let's finish by slipped stitch (sl st)


Cut the yarn and fasten off.


Let's sew the head! The doll is ready! Lucky crocheting!!!
