The bright tubular blooms of the Firecracker plant are a magnet for hummingbirds, bees and butterflies. Clean off the chaff and let dry indoors. Store in jars, envelopes, or paper bags (not plastic) to plant in November. When you put water on the seed pods of this plant, they POP out, sometimes as far away as 12 feet! The best way to harvest the seeds is to put the dry seed pods in a jar, add water and place your hand over the rim (very quickly) to keep the seeds from popping out, and then lay them out to dry on a paper towel! Firecracker plant related species: *Cuphea hyssopifolia*, or Mexican heather, is a tender perennial used primarily for bedding out, except in frost-free areas. Leaves are tiny, and the plant is nearly obscured by the small white, lavender, or lilac-colored flowers that bloom over a long season. Growing to 1 foot, it spreads wider than its height. There is another plant *Dichelostemma ida-maia*, bearing the same common name (Firecracker Flower) as *Crossandra infundibuliformis*.
