YARN:

for height 18 cm (22 cm with ears) use:

- Semyonovskaya LADA, 380m/100g (15% wool, 35% alpaca, 50% acrilic)
- DROPS Alpaca uni color, 167m/50g (100% alpaca)
- DROPS Flora mix, 210m/50g (65% wool, 35% alpaca)

or other yarn you like

OTHER MATERIALS:

- hook 1.25 mm or in accordance with yarn you use
- cheap plastic boxes, caps for plastic cans or thick cardboard for insoles
- fiberfill for stuffing
- cooper wire for neck 1.0 mm 30 cm
- dental floss or braided line for sewing
- needles for sewing: long and short with large eyelet for sewing parts
- 6-8 mm black plastic eyes with loops
- Slicker brush to backcomb your toy

ABBREVIATIONS (US TERMS):

ch = chain stitch

sc = single crochet stitch

dec = single crochet decrease (sc next 2 stitches together)

inc = single crochet increase (sc in indicated stitch 2 times)

hdc = half double crochet

hdc dec = half double crochet decrease (hdc next 2 stitches together)

hdc inc = half double crochet increase (hdc in indicated stitch 2 times)

rnd(s) = round(s)

sk = skip

slst = slip stitch

slst dec = slip stitch decrease (slst next 2 stitches together)

st(s) = stitch(es)

...-tbl = through back loops only

...-tfl = through front loops only

dc = double crochet stitch

[...] x... = repeat instructions

in brackets ... times

(...) = total number of sts in current rnd



NOTES:

- 1. Do not join rounds, work in a continuous spiral unless otherwise stated.
- 2. Take care to crochet very tight stitches! If you crochet rather loosely, use a smaller hook size.
- 3. Stuff your amigurumi as you go. Use a chopstick for that!
- 4. Fasten off your work always with needle join and you will get a neat result.
- 5. You can use a stitch marker or a piece of yarn to mark the beginning of a round.
- 6. For a child under age of 3, you should rather use black yarn to embroider the eyes instead of using toy eyes made from plastic or glass.








Continue to stuff head (pics 4, 5). Insert the end of the wire in the head as shown in picture 6, add stuffing.


Fold the lower and top parts of the foot together (top part is in the front). Insert hook into the corresponding stitches on both layers to crochet them together (pic. 14).


Crochet 20 st, than insert the insole in the middle of two parts and begin to stuff (pic.15). 9 st, stuff the foot as tight as you can, crochet last 3st (pic. 16).


Break the yarn, fasten off and weave in ends.











LEGS (make 2):


Break the yarn with a long rest and pull the yarn tail through the last stitch completely (pic. 17) Stuff the leg and sew it together with the foot as shown on picture 18, weave in ends.

EARS (make 2):

Make a chain of 11 ch, start in the 2nd stich from the hook:




TAIL:

Make a chain of 10 ch, start in the 2nd stich from the hook:

1. 9 slst (9)


Break the yarn with a long rest and pull the yarn tail through the last stitch completely (pic. 21). Now take two short pieces of yarn and make a tassel as shown in pictures 22-26.

Break the yarn with a long rest and pull the yarn tail through the last stitch completely (pics 27, 28)



MAKE A TOY FLUFFY:

Use slicker brush to comb every detail. So your toy become fluffy

SHAPING THE HEAD:

From the top of the head we retreat down 17 rows. Eyes will be place between 17 and 18 rows, with 16 loops distance.


But we need to make a tightening at first for the face to be voluminous.

Use the thread of yarn with braided line (or dental floss) about 25 cm and the long needle (pic. 29)

Put the needle through the point 1 (first eye), point 2, point 3 (second eye) and back 3-2-1 (pic. 30)

Tight the threads in point 1 (you've got two slots for eyes) and tie them. Hide the threads in the body.






EYES, NOSE, MOUTH:


In the slots sew on eyes (or you can embroider them if you want).

Sew the nose in place marked on picture 31



SEWING ARMS AND LEGS:

Use the thread of yarn with braided line (or dental floss) about 25 cm and the long needle (pic. 29) Sew as shown on pictures 32-34.








SEWING EARS & TAIL:

Sew the ears and tail in right position onto the body as shown on pictures 35, 36.



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
