Chocolate Copper Color



SKILL LEVEL:

Rnd: round

Ch: chain stitch slst: slip stitch

sc : single crochet stitch
st, sts : stitch, stitches

dec: single crochet 2 stitches in front loops together

inc: single crochet 2 stitches in same sc

hdc: half double crochet stitch

<...>: join the < c o | o r> yarn

(....) x : repeat instructions in bracestimes

NOTE:

when changing color and join yarn:

- Work in the previous color yarn until two loops of the last stitch remain on the hook.
- Use the new color yarn to complete the stitch, continue working with the new color yarn. Do not cut color yarn that will be needed later on.

I use smaller yarn black for embroidering.

It's highly recommended that you read through the pattern completely before beginning to crochet.

MATERIALS

Worsted yarn

Sorrel yarn (Katia Merino 100% No.13)

White yarn (Katia Merino 100% No.1)

Black yarn (Katia Merino 100% No.2)

Crochet Hook 2.5mm

Stuffing Fiberfill

Gold Bell 6mm

Saety Noise 6mm

Safety Eyes black 6mm x 2

SIZE: 16cm (6.3 inches)
(If using fingering weight yarn on a 2.5mm crochet hook)



HEAD

Begin with sorrel yarn:

Rnd 1:6 sc in the magic ring [6]

Rnd 2:6 inc [12]

Rnd 3: (1 sc, inc) x 6 [18]

Rnd 4: (2 sc, inc) x 6 [24]

Rnd 5: (3 sc, inc) x 6 [30]

Rnd 6: (4 sc, inc) x 6 [36]

Rnd 7: < sorrel > 4 sc, < white > 3 sc, < sorrel > 2 sc,

< white > 3 sc, < sorrel > 24 sc [36]

Rnd 8: < sorrel > 3 sc, < white > 4 sc, < sorrel > 2 sc,

< white > 4 sc, < sorrel > 23 sc [36]

Rnd 9: < sorrel > 2 sc, < white > 5 sc, < sorrel > 2 sc,

< white > 5 sc, < sorrel > 22 sc [36]

Rnd 10:< sorrel > 1 sc, < white > 6 sc, < sorrel > 2 sc,

< white > 6 sc, < sorrel > 21 sc [36]

Change the color to white:

Rnd 11: (2 sc, inc) x 12 [48]

Rnd 12 - Rnd 15: sc in all 48 st [48]

Insert the safety eyes between rounds 10 and 11,

with an interspace of 6 stitches.

Rnd 16: (4 sc, dec) x 8 [40]

Rnd 17: (3 sc, dec) x 8 [32]

Rnd 18: (2 sc, dec) x 8 [24]

Fill the head with stuffing material.

Rnd 19: (1 sc, dec) x 8 [16]

Rnd 20: 8 dec [8]

Fasten off.

Using your yarn needle, weave the yarn tail through

the front loop of each remaining stitch

and pull it tight.

Embroider eyebrows on round 8 with black yarn.

























EARS

OUTER EAR (*2):

Begin with sorrel:

Rnd 1:4 sc in the magic ring [4]

Rnd 2:4 inc [8]

Rnd 3:8 sc [8]

Rnd 4: (1 sc, 1 inc) * 4 [12]

Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing.

INNER EAR (*2):

Begin with white:

Chain 3, 1 sc on the 2nd chain from the hook,

1 hdc

Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing.

Sew the inner ear to the outer ear between

Rnd 1 and 3.

Sew the ear to the head between Rnd 4 and 7









<u>SNOUT</u>

Begin with white:

Rnd 1:6 sc in the magic ring [6]

Rnd 2: 6 inc [12]

Rnd 3: (4 sc, 2 inc)* 2 [16]

Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing.

Embroider snout same pic with black yarn.

Insert the safety snout between Rnd 1 and 2

Sew the snout to the head between Rnd 11 and 13

Space controls



COLLAR

Begin with black:

Rnd 1: chain 31, 1 sc on the 2nd chain from the

hook, 29 sc

Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing.

BODY

First, we start with the neck. Begin with sorrel yarn:

Rnd 1 : Chain 20, connect first chain to MAKE A RING,

continue working in a spiral 20 sc [20]

Rnd 2: Slst, Chain 13, 1 inc on the 2nd chain

FROM THE HOOK, 11 sc on the chain, 1 sc in the stitch

where the foundation chain starts, 19 sc on the neck,

11 sc on the other side of the chain, 1 inc in the last st [46]

Place the stitch marker in the next stitch.

Rnd 3: <sorrel > 1 sc, 1 inc, 20 sc,

< white > 1 inc, 2 sc, 1 inc, <sorrel > 19 sc, 1 inc [50]

Rnd 4: <sorrel > 2 sc, 1 inc, 20 sc,

< white > 6 sc, <sorrel > 19 sc, 1 inc, 1 sc [52]

Rnd 5: <sorrel > 3 sc, 1 inc, 20 sc,

< white > 1 inc, 4 sc, 1 inc, <sorrel > 19 sc, 1 inc, 2 sc [56]

Rnd 6: <sorrel > 4 sc, 1 inc, 20 sc,

< white > 1 inc, 6 sc, 1 inc, <sorrel > 19 sc, 1 inc, 3 sc [60]

Rnd 7: $\langle sorrel \rangle 26 sc, \langle white \rangle 8 sc,$

<sorrel > 26 sc [60]

Rnd 8: <sorrel > 27 sc, < white > 6 sc,

<sorrel > 27 sc [60]

Rnd 9: <sorrel > 28 sc, < white > 5 sc,

<sorrel > 27 sc [60]

Rnd 10: <sorrel > 29 sc, < white > 4 sc,

<sorrel > 27 sc [60]

Rnd 11: $\langle sorrel \rangle 30 sc, \langle white \rangle 3 sc,$

<sorrel > 27 sc [60] do not cut yarn to continue the leg

Now, we work space between front 2 legs, in rows

with white yarn on 3 st white on Rnd 11:

Row 1 - Row 3: Ch 1, 3 sc, turn [3]

Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing.



LEGS

First, You need mark the postion of the 4 legs:

9 st for the first leg form space white between fronts

2 legs, 9 st for space belly,

9 st for the second leg, 3 st for space on middle back,

9 st for the third leg, 9 st for space belly,

9 st for the fourth leg.

(I do not cut sorrel yarn on rnd 11 of body,

first I made leg 2)





Leg 1:

Join sorrel yarn to round 11 of the body, on the right-hand side of the 3 st space between

front 2 legs

Rnd 1:9 sc on the body, 6 chain

Rnd 2: 9 sc on the body, 6 sc on the chain [15]

Rnd 3: 15 sc [15]

Rnd 4: (3 sc, 1 dec) * 3 [12]

Rnd 5 - Rnd 6: 12 sc [12]

Rnd 7:6 dec [6]

Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing. Using your yarn needle, weaves the yarn tail through the front loop of each remaining stitch and pull it tight.

Leg 2:

Skip next 9 st on round 11 of body after leg 1.

Join sorrel yarn in this stitch.

Start the second leg:

Rnd 1 – Rnd 7: repeat Rnd 1 – Rnd 7 for the Leg 1.

Leg 3:

Skip next 3 st on round 11 of body after leg 2.

Join sorrel yarn in this stitch.

Start the third leg:

Rnd 1 – Rnd 7: repeat Rnd 1 – Rnd 7 for the Leg 1.

Leg 4:

Skip next 9 st on round 11 of body after leg 3.

Join sorrel yarn in this stitch.

Start the four leg:

Rnd 1 – Rnd 7: repeat Rnd 1 – Rnd 7 for the Leg 1.









BELLY

Join sorrel yarn to round 11 of the body, on the right-hand side of the 9 st space belly


between leg 1 and leg 2, work in rows:

Row 1 - Row 9: Ch1, 9 sc, turn [9]

Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewwing.

SPACE BETWEEN 2 BACK LEGS:

Join sorrel yarn to round 11 of the body, on the right-hand side of the 3 st space belly between leg 2 and leg 3, work in rows:







<u>TAIL</u>

Begin with white:

Rnd 1: 3 sc in the magic ring [3]

Rnd 2:3 inc [6]

Rnd 3:6 sc [6]

Rnd 4 : < white > 1 sc, <sorrel > 1 sc,

< white > 1 sc, <sorrel > 1 sc,

< white > 1 sc, <sorrel > 1 sc [6]

Change the color to sorrel:

Rnd 5: 4 sc, 1 dec [5]

Rnd 6 - Rnd 8 : 5 sc [5]

Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing.

Sew the tail to the body between round 2 and 3
