



## Kawaii Strawberry - Rattle

No. 1011-194-1588

**Skill level:** Advanced

**Size approx.:** 15 x 6 cm

**Crochet hook:** 2,5 mm

**Materials:** Wooden ring 68 mm, pins, black embroidery thread, toy stuffing, sewing thread, sewing needle, safety eyes 7 mm, round rattle.

**Abbreviation:**

**m** - stitch

**ch** - chain stitch

**sc** - single crochet

**inc 1 st** - work 2 sc in same stitch

**dec 1 st** - work 2 stitches together

**sl st** - slip stitch

**hdc** - half double crochet

**Yarn:** Rainbow Cotton 8/4.

**How much yarn do you need?**

**Red (58)** - 1 ball

**Yellow (54)** - 1 ball

**Malachite Green (99)** - 1 ball

**White (01)** - 1 ball

**Pink (44)** - 1 ball

**Pastel mint (25)** - 1 ball

### **Tip!**

Use a stitch marker or safety pin to keep track of where the round begins. A wooden chopstick is perfect to use to get the piece thoroughly stuffed ☺

## **Strawberry**

*Work with red*

Make a magic ring

**R 1:** 6 sc in ring (6),

**R 2:** [inc 1 st] x 6 (12),

**R 3:** 12 sc (12),

**R 4:** [1 sc, inc 1 st] x 6 (18),

**R 5:** 18 sc (18),

**R 6:** [2 sc, inc 1 st] x 6 (24),

**R 7:** 24 sc (24),

**R 8:** [3 sc, inc 1 st] x 6 (30),

**R 9:** 30 sc (30),

**R 10:** [4 sc, inc 1 st] x 6 (36),

**R 11:** 36 sc (36),

**R 12:** [5 sc, inc 1 st] x 6 (42),

**R 13:** 42 sc (42),

**R 14:** [6 sc, inc 1 st] x 6 (48),

**R 15-21:** 48 sc (7 rounds, 48).

Embroider the mouth and cheeks on to the strawberry and attach the safety eyes.

Embroider the mouth as a "V" in the middle of round 14. Attach the eyes in between round 15 and 16. Embroider little cheeks on the outside of each eye (see photo).

**R 22:** [6 sc, dec 1 st] x 6 (42),

**R 23:** [5 sc, dec 1 st] x 6 (36),

**R 24:** [4 sc, dec 1 st] x 6 (30),

Stuff the strawberry continuously, and the hole gets smaller. Don't forget to add the little rattle.

**R 25:** [3 sc, dec 1 st] x 6 (24),

**R 26:** [2 sc, dec 1 st] x 6 (18),

**R 27:** [1 sc, dec 1 st] x 6 (12),

**R 28:** [dec 1 st] x 6 (6).

Sew the hole together but leave a 30 cm long end for assembly.

Use a long darning needle and pull the needle and thread through the strawberry from top to bottom. Make a little stitch and pull hereafter the needle back up again through the strawberry, from bottom to top. Tighten the thread a little. The reason you do this, is to give the strawberry a flatter bottom to make it fit better on the wooden ring.

## Strawberry leaves

*Work with Malachite Green*

Make a magic ring

**R 1:** 6 sc in ring (6),

**R 2:** [inc 1 st] x 6 (12),

**R 3:** [1 sc, inc 1 st] x 6 (18),

**R 4:** 1 sc, inc 1 st [2 sc, inc 1 st] x 5, 1 sc (24),

**R 5:** [3 sc, inc 1 st] x 6 (30),

**R 6:** 2 sc, inc 1 st [4 sc, inc 1 st] x 5, 2 sc (36).

Now you work the parts, that hang over the sides of the strawberry:

\*Ch 6, begin in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook and work 1 hdc in each ch (4).

Work 3 sl st in the edge of the circle \* repeat from \* on entire round.

## Stem

*With Malachite Green*

Ch 6, begin in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook and work 5 sc.

Break the yarn, but leave a long end for assembly.

Attach the stem on the top of the strawberry leaves with pins.

## Flower

*Work with yellow*

Begin by making a magic ring

**R 1:** work 5 sc in the magic ring (5)

*Change to White*

**R 2:** work in the same stitch 5 times as follows: [1 sl st, 1 sc, 1 dc, 1 sc, 1 sl st] x 5.

Finish with 1 sl st. Weave in ends, but leave a long end to sew the flower on to the strawberry.

## Piece for wooden ring

*Work with Pastel mint*

Ch 25 and begin in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook.

**R 1–9:** 24 sc (Work 9 rows back and forth, turn with ch 1).

Break the yarn, but leave a long end for assembly.

## Assembly

Sew the leaf on to the top of the strawberry and sew also the parts that hang over the sides on to the strawberry.

Sew the flower on one side of the strawberry.

Fold the crocheted piece around the wooden ring and sew it together. You can see how to do this on the photos in the instruction below.

Fasten the strawberry on top of the ring using the pins and sew it thoroughly on to the ring.

Done! 😊
