## Materials and instruments

- Yarn of the same weight (2 fine, sport, baby, 4 Ply).
- White (Yarn Art JEANS, Color 62, 50g/160m/174yds, 55\% cotton/45\% polyacryl) approximately $\quad 30 \mathrm{~g}$.
- Light brown (Yarn Art JEANS, Color 07, 50g/160m/174yds, $55 \%$ cotton/45\% polyacryl) approximately 3 g .
- Red (Yarn Art JEANS, Color 90, 50g/160m/174yds, 55\% cotton/45\% polyacryl) approximately 60 g .
- Brown (Yarn Art JEANS, Color 70, 50g/160m/174yds, $55 \%$ cotton/45\% polyacryl) approximately $\quad 10 \mathrm{~g}$.
- Green (Alize Cotton Gold, Color 126, 100g/330m/361yds, 55\% cotton/45\% polyacryl) approximately $\quad 5 \mathrm{~g}$.
- Stuffing material - fiberfill (holofiber) approximately 70 g .
- Crochet hook size 2.25 mm (US: $\mathrm{B} / 1, \mathrm{UK}: 13$ )
- Yarn needle
- Scissors
- Stitch marker
- Pipe cleaner, 30 cm (11 7/9 inch)
- 40 beads (diameter 3 mm )

* The size of the product depends on the yarn and hook you have chosen.

If you are using the same materials, your finished toy should be approximately:

## Gnome:

25 cm (10 inch) - Hight with the straight top,
21 cm ( 8 1/4 inch) - Hight with the bent top.
Cup without decor:

## 9 cm (3 1/2 inch)

* Use a marker at the beginning of the row.
* Pay attention to recommendations for crochet density. Crochet density of the details is medium.
* Use pipe cleaner folded in half if you want the bent top to have a proper shape. Insert it into the top.

IMPORTANT! The way of counting the stitches with FPsc is described in cylindrical marshmallows pattern.

## FPsc - front post single crochet

When starting FPsc insert the hook where the previous sc was made.
(2) Insert your hook from front to back on the first side of the stitch, then bring it back out from back to front on the other side of the stitch.
(3) Yarn over.
(4) Pull up a loop around that post.
(5) Yarn over.

6 Draw the yarn through the two loops on the hook.




7 Crochet the next stitch here ( sc )
$8[3 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{FPsc}]^{*} 2$, 3 sc
9 Crochet the last FPsc of the round under the marker (from the loop that belongs to the next round).
This FPsc is already sixteenth stitch but total number of stitches in a round remains 15.
It means that in rounds 4-11 we crochet 16 stitches and after that we move marker.
In such a case the start of the next round will be shifted left after each round by one stitch.
(10) End of rnd 4.
(11) Set marker. Beginning of rnd 5 .

FO and hide the tails of the yarn inside the detail.
6 Make 7 more ribs.

Fold the top of the gnome's hat.
You can decorate the top of the hat by stitching a small meringue.

You can decorate the gnome's hat and the cup with meringues and leaves with berries.

Sew the beads to the gnome's hat and the cup.
