## MATERIALS & TOOLS

Yarn → I used Schachenmayr Catania and Scheepjes Sweet Treat.

→ 1,50mm, 2,00mm and 2,50mm crochet hooks or according to the yarn.

→ Wire 2,00mm (106cm).

→ Polyester fiberfill for stuffing.

→ Safety eyes (6mm).

→ Yarn needle, sewing needle, scissors, stitch marker, 2 buttons (6mm) and a piece of green ribbon.

## ABBREVIATIONS

**mr** → magic ring

**ch** → chain stitch

**sl.st** → slip stitch

**sc** → single crochet stitch

**hdc** → half double crochet stitch

**dc** → double crochet stitch

**inc** → increase – crochet two single crochet stitches in the same stitch

**hdc-inc** → increase – crochet two half double crochet stitches in the same stitch

**dc-inc** → increase – crochet two double crochet stitches in the same stitch

**dec** → invisible decrease two stitches together using the invisible decrease method

**sc3tog** → single crochet three stitches together

**shift stitch** → extra regular stitch

**\*...\*** → \*repeat following directions\* as many times as indicated

**[...]** → work directions inside square brackets into stitch as indicated

## SIZE OF THE DOLL

The size of the doll is 28 cm.

If you use different yarns than those indicated in the pattern, it is possible you may need to crochet more or less rounds for the clothes.

## CROCHET TERMINOLOGY

This pattern is designed by using US terminology.

## NOTES

Work in continuous rounds (no joining required), do not join rounds or turn, unless instructed otherwise in the pattern.

Use a stitch marker to mark the end or the beginning of a round.

All stitches are worked into both loops, unless instructed otherwise in the pattern.

Stuff your doll as you go.

**DRESS With yarn F** Crochet hook **2,50mm.**

Begin with Ch 36 and join with a sc (counts as your 1<sup>st</sup> stitch of the next round) to the first chain to create a circle.

rnd		sts
1	*5 sc, inc* 6 times	42 sc
2	6 sc, ch 6, skip 8 stitches, 14 sc, ch 6, skip 8 stitches, 6 sc	38 sts



3	*8 sc, inc* 4 times, 2 sc	42 sc
4-5	(2 rnds) 1 sc in each stitch around	42 sc
6	*6 sc, 1 inc* 6 times	48 sc
7	1 sc in each stitch around	48 sc
8	Work in the <b>BACK</b> loops, *1 sc, 1 inc* 24 times	72 sc
9-28	(20 rnds) Work in both loops, 1 sc in each stitch around	72 sc

Fasten off with a slip stitch. Weave in the end with the needle join method. To do that,

1. Cut the yarn and pull the loop out of the top of the stitch.
2. Thread the end into a needle. Insert the needle under both loops of the first full stitch of the round and pull the yarn through.
3. Insert the needle into the top of the last stitch, where the yarn end comes from, and bring it out toward the back.
4. Insert the needle under the back loops of the stitch at the back of the shirt.
5. Tighten the loop to match the rest of the stitches and secure the yarn as usual.



**SLEEVES With yarn E**

Crochet hook **2,50mm.**

Do not turn the dress upside down.

rnd		sts
1	Join yarn <b>E</b> , 6 sc (along the chain 6), 8 hdc-inc (in the unworked stitches of round 2 of the dress), and 1 sc on each side of the sleeve (6+1+16+1= 24), join with a sl.st.	24 sts



Fasten off and weave in the end with the needle join method.

**DRESS CUFF With yarn E**

Crochet hook **2,50mm.**

Turn the dress upside down. Attach yarn **E** to the back center of round 8 of the dress (see photo).

1	Work in the <b>FRONT</b> loops, 1 sl.st. in each stitch around	48 sl.sts
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Fasten off with and weave in the end.



### BUNNY APPLIQUE With yarn E

Crochet hook 2,00mm.

#### HEAD

row		sts
1	Ch 9, start in the 2 <sup>nd</sup> chain from the hook, 1 sc in each chain across, turn	8 sc
2	Ch 1, 1 dec, 4 sc, 1 dec, turn	6 sc
3	Ch 1, 1 sc in each stitch across, turn	6 sc
4	Ch 1, 1 dec, 2 sc, 1 dec, DO NOT turn	4 sc

Crochet around the head working 1 sc in each stitch and 2 in each corner.

Fasten off leaving a yarn tail long enough to sew the applique onto the dress.

- ➔ Embroider the eyes with black embroidery thread.
- ➔ With pink embroidery thread sew the nose and the mouth.

#### EARS (Make two)

row		sts
1	Ch 8, start in the 2 <sup>nd</sup> chain from the hook, 2 sl.sts., 3 sc, 1 hdc, 1 hdc-inc, work down the other side of the chain, 2 hdc, 3 sc, 2 sl.sts.	15 sts

Fasten off leaving a yarn tail long enough to sew the ears onto the head.

Repeat round 1 to make the second ear.

- ➔ Take a small brush and lightly color the inside of the ears using pink shadow.

Sew the ears onto the head (see photo).

#### LEGS (Make two)

1	4 hdc, 1 sl.st., in a mr	5 sts
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Fasten off leaving a yarn tail long enough to sew the legs onto the dress.



Sew the applique and the legs onto the dress (see photo).

#### ARMS Start with yarn A (Make two)

DO NOT stuff the arms. Crochet hook 2,50mm.

rnd		sts
1	6 sc in magic ring	6 sc
2	*1 inc, 2 sc* 2 times	8 sc
3	1 sc in each stitch around	8 sc
4	*1 inc, 3 sc* 2 times	10 sc

Change to yarn B in the last stitch of round 4: Start by leaving a yarn tail approximately 50cm long. We will use it at the end to finish the arm. Pull remaining yarn B to the front of your work (see photo).

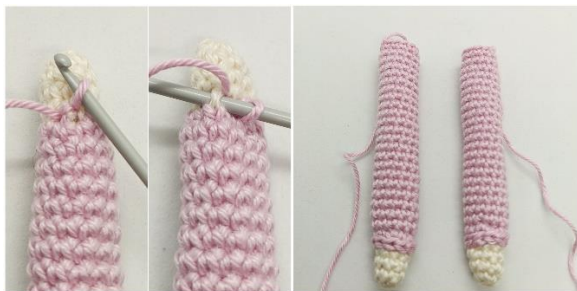


5	Work in the <b>FRONT</b> loops, 1 sl.st. in first st., 3 sc, 1 inc, 4 sc, 1 inc	12 sts
6-27	Work in both loops, (22 rnds) 1 sc in each stitch around	12 sc

Fasten off with a slip stitch and weave in the end with the needle join method.

By using remaining yarn **B** work between rounds 4-5 of the arm.

**1** 1 slip stitch in each stitch around 10 sl.sts



Fasten off and weave in the end.

**BOOT SOLE** With yarn **C**

Crochet hook **2,50mm**. DO NOT stuff the legs as you go. We are going to stuff them later.

Begin with Ch 7.

rnd	sts
<b>1</b> Start in the 2 <sup>nd</sup> chain from the hook, 5 sc, [3 sc] into last chain, work down the other side of the chain 5 sc, 1 inc	15 sc
<b>2</b> 1 inc, 5 sc, 3 inc, 5 sc, 1 inc	20 sc
<b>3</b> 1 inc, 7 sc, 4 inc, 7 sc, 1 inc	26 sc
<b>4</b> 1 inc, 9 sc, 4 inc, 11 sc, 1 inc	32 sc

On the next round, crochet a slip stitch in each stitch around (make sure it is big enough or use crochet hook 3,00mm so you can work into it easily).

**5** 1 sl.st. in each stitch around, join with a sl.st. 32 sl.sts



Fasten off and weave in the end.

Cut two pieces of cardboard in size of the sole.

**6** Join yarn **D** in your last slip stitch 32 sc on round 5. Work in both loops, Ch 1, 1 sc in each stitch around, join with a sl.st.



**7-9** (3 rnds) Work in both loops, Ch 1, 1 sc in each stitch around, join with a sl.st. 32 sc

**10** Ch 1, 10 sc, \*1 dec, 1 sc\* 4 times, 10 sc, join with a sl.st. 28 sc

Put the cardboard in the bottom of the sole, so that the doll will stand upright more easily.

**11** Ch 1, 8 sc, \*1 dec, 1 sc\* 4 times, 8 sc, join with a sl.st. 24 sc

Cut the yarn, (leave a yarn tail approximately 120cm long, we will use it at the end to finish the shoe). Pull remaining yarn **D** to the front of your work (see photo).



**SOCKS** Crochet hook **2,50mm**.

Rounds 12-19 are crocheted with yarn **E** and yarn **F**

Change to yarn E in the last stitch of each round: Pull up a loop with the yarn you are working and finish the stitch with the contrast one. Start with yarn F (The rounds of the socks that are crocheted with yarn F are in green).



rnd		sts
12	Change to yarn E in the last slip stitch of round 11. Work in the <b>BACK</b> loops, 8 sc, 4 dec, 8 sc	20 sc
13	Work in both loops, 6 sc, 4 dec, 6 sc	16 sc
14	6 sc, 2 dec, 6 sc	14 sc



15	1 sc in each stitch around	14 sc
16	1 sc in each stitch around	14 sc
17	1 sc in each stitch around	14 sc
18	1 sc in each stitch around	14 sc
19	1 sc in each stitch around, 1 shift stitch.	14 sc

Fasten off with a slip stitch.

Cut the yarn, (leave a yarn tail approximately 80cm long, we will use it at the end to finish the socks).

Pull remaining yarn F to the front of your work (see photo).

Use two pieces of wire 40cm in length (one for each leg) and bend it as shown in the picture. Wrap each wire with tape and insert it into the legs (see photo). Stuff the feet and the legs.



#### LEFT SHOE STRAP With yarn D

Crochet hook 2,50mm.

Do not turn the shoe upside down.

Using the remaining yarn D work in the **FRONT** loops of round 12, 6 sl.sts., Ch 13, start in the 5<sup>th</sup> chain from the hook (picot for the button), work down the chain, 1 sl.st. in each of the remaining chains 9 sl.sts., 18 sl.sts. (on round 12).

Fasten off and weave in the end with the needle join method.

#### RIGHT SHOE STRAP With yarn D

Crochet hook 2,50mm.

Do not turn the shoe upside down.

Using the remaining yarn D work in the **FRONT** loops of round 12, 18 sl.sts., Ch 13, start in the 5<sup>th</sup> chain from the hook (picot for the button), work down the chain, 1 sl.st. in each of the remaining chains 9 sl.sts., 6 sl.sts. (on round 12).

Fasten off and weave in the end with the needle join method.

Sew one button on the sides of each shoe (see photo).





Continue the leg.

### LEG

Join yarn A in the slip stitch of round 19:

| <b>30-32</b> | (3 rnds) 1 sc in each stitch around  | 20 sc |

| <b>34-37</b> | (4 rnds) 1 sc in each stitch around  | 22 sc |

Fasten off with a slip stitch and weave in the end with the needle join method.

### SOCKS CUFF With yarn F

Crochet hook **2,50mm**.

Turn the leg upside down.

Using the remaining yarn F work in the **FRONT** loops of round 20, 1 slip stitch in each stitch around = 14 slip stitches



Fasten off and weave in the end.

### LEFT LEG

Repeat rounds 1-37. **DO NOT** cut the yarn.

It is possible you may need to crochet two or three sc less for round 37.

Find the stitches at the center of the inner side of the legs.

In the next round, we'll join the legs together.

**BODY** With yarn G Stuff the body as you go.

Crochet hook **2,50mm**.

The front of the doll is facing you.

Change to yarn G in the last stitch of round 37:

**Ch 3**, join to the right leg in the stitch you marked earlier.






- 38 22 sc (around the 1<sup>st</sup> leg), 3 sc (along the chain), 22 sc (around the 2<sup>nd</sup> leg), 3 sc (along the bottom of the chain) 50 sc
- 39 \*22 sc, 1 inc, 1 sc, 1 inc\* 2 times 54 sc
- 40 \*22 sc, 1 inc, 3 sc, 1 inc\* 2 times 58 sc
- 41 \*25 sc, 1 inc, 3 sc\* 2 times 60 sc
- 42-44 (3 rnds) 1 sc in each stitch around 60 sc
- 45 \*1 dec, 8 sc\* 6 times 54 sc
- 46-47 (2 rnds) 1 sc in each stitch around 54 sc

Crochet as many stitches as necessary to reach the center back of the doll and place your stitch marker into the last stitch.

Twist the two pieces of wire.

Change to yarn B  in the last stitch of round 47:

- 48 1 sc in each stitch around 54 sc



- 49 Work in the **BACK** loops, 48 sc  
\*Skip one stitch, 8 sc\* 6 times
- 50-52 (3 rnds) Work in both loops, 48 sc  
1 sc in each stitch around
- 53 \*1 dec, 6 sc\* 6 times 42 sc
- 54-57 (4 rnds), 1 sc in each stitch around 42 sc
- 58 \*1 dec, 5 sc\* 6 times 36 sts
- 59-64 (6 rnds), 1 sc in each stitch around 36 sc

Crochet as many stitches as necessary to reach the center back of the doll and place your stitch marker into the last stitch.

We are going to connect the arms in the next round.

- 65 6 sc, \*sc3tog\* 2 times, (3 stitches of the 1<sup>st</sup> arm and 3 stitches of round 63 of the body together), 12 sc, \*sc3tog\* 2 times, (3 stitches of the 2<sup>nd</sup> arm and 3 stitches of round 63 of the body together), 6 sc 28 sc



- 66 4 sc, 1 dec, skip the two sc3tog, 2 sc, 1 dec, 2 sc, in the outer (unworked) stitches of the 1<sup>st</sup> arm, 1 dec, 8 sc, 1 dec, skip the two sc3tog, 2 sc, 1 dec, 2 sc, in the outer (unworked) stitches of the 2<sup>nd</sup> arm, 1 dec, 4 sc 30 sts

The two sc3tog from round 65 are left unworked. Use a length of wire 26cm long and bend it as shown in the picture. Wrap the wire with tape and insert it into the arms. **DO NOT** stuff the arms.





**67** \*1 dec, 3 sc\* 6 times 24 sc

**68** 1 sc in each stitch around 24 sc

Cut the yarn, (leave a yarn tail approximately 180cm long, we will use it at the end to finish the collar). Pull remaining yarn **B** to the front of your work (see photo).

Change to yarn **A** in the last stitch of round 68:

**69** Work in the **BACK** loops, \*2 sc, skip one stitch, 1 sc\* 6 times 18 sc

**70** Work in both loops, \*1 dec, 1 sc\* 6 times 12 sc



**71-74** (4 rnds) 1 sc in each stitch around 12 sc

Stuff the remaining body and the neck with fiberfill.

Continue the skirt.

**SKIRT** With yarn **B** Crochet hook **2,50mm**.

Turn the doll upside down. We will now make the skirt. Join yarn **B** to the back center of round 49 (see photo).



**rnd** sts

**1** Work in the **FRONT** loops, Ch 3, 96 dc  
1 dc-inc in each stitch around, join with a sl.st.

**2-6** (5 rnds) Work in both loops, Ch 3, 96 sc  
1 dc in each stitch around, join with a sl.st.

Change to yarn **H** in the last stitch of round 6:



Crochet hook **1,50mm**.

**7** Work in the **BACK** loops, 1 dc-inc 192 dc  
in each stitch around, join with a sl.st.

Fasten off and weave in the end with the needle join method.

Continue the collar.

**COLLAR** With yarn **B** Crochet hook **2,50mm**.

Do not turn the doll upside down. We will now make the collar using the tail that we left before.

Work in the **FRONT** loops starting to the back center of round 68 (see photo).

**1** 7 hdc, 1 dc, 3 dc-inc, 2 sl.sts., 3 dc-inc, 24 sts  
1 dc, 7 hdc, join with a sl.st.


Fasten off and weave in the end.



We are going to dress the doll with the dress. To do that, **CUT** the yarn, dress the doll with the dress, and then continue the head. Stuff the remaining body and the neck with fiberfill.



Continue the head.

**HEAD** With yarn A  Stuff the head as you go.  
Crochet hook **2,50mm**.

rnd		sts
1	*Inc* 12 times	24 sc
2	*3 sc, 1 inc* 6 times	30 sc
3	2 sc, 1 inc, *4 sc, 1 inc* 5 times, 2 sc	36 sc
4	*5 sc, 1 inc* 6 times	42 sc
5	3 sc, 1 inc, *6 sc, 1 inc* 5 times, 3 sc	48 sc
6	*7 sc, 1 inc* 6 times	54 sc
7	4 sc, 1 inc, *8 sc, 1 inc* 5 times, 4 sc	60 sc
8	*9 sc, 1 inc* 6 times	66 sc
9-12	(4 rnds) 1 sc in each stitch around	66 sc

Crochet as many stitches as necessary to reach the center back of the head and place your stitch marker into the last stitch.

13	21 sc, *1 dec, 2 sc* 3 times, *2 sc, 1 dec* 3 times, 21 sc	60 sc
14-17	(4 rnds) 1 sc in each stitch around	60 sc
18	*9 sc, 1 inc* 6 times	66 sc
19-23	(5 rnds) 1 sc in each stitch around	66 sc



- Insert the safety eyes between rounds 12-13 leaving a space of 7 stitches between them.
- Embroider the eyebrows with brown embroidery thread.
- Sew the nose in the middle of the eyes between rounds 11-12.
- Sew the ears between rounds 11-12 with 4 stitches distance from each eye.

**EARS** With yarn A  (Make two)

Crochet hook **2,50mm**.

2 sc, 3 hdc, 2 sc in a magic ring = 7 sts

Fasten off. Draw the loop tightly closed leaving a yarn tail long enough to sew the ears onto the head.



Continue the head.

24	*1 dec, 9 sc* 6 times	60 sc
25	*1 dec, 8 sc* 6 times	54 sc
26	*1 dec, 7 sc* 6 times	48 sc
27	*1 dec, 6 sc* 6 times	42 sc
28	*1 dec, 5 sc* 6 times	36 sc
29	*1 dec, 4 sc* 6 times	30 sc
30	*1 dec, 3 sc* 6 times	24 sc
31	*1 dec, 2 sc* 6 times	18 sc
32	*1 dec, 1 sc* 6 times	12 sc
33	*dec* 6 times	6 sc

Cut the yarn and close the opening.

Weave the end through the front loop of each remaining stitch and pull tight to close.

Make a knot and hide the end.



Fasten off and weave in the end with the needle join method.

**WIG CAP With yarn I** ■ Crochet hook 2,50mm.

rnd		sts
1	6 sc in magic ring	6 sc
2	*Inc* 6 times	12 sc
3	*1 sc, 1 inc* 6 times	18 sc
4	*2 sc, 1 inc* 6 times	24 sc
5	*3 sc, 1 inc* 6 times	30 sc
6	*4 sc, 1 inc* 6 times	36 sc
7	*5 sc, 1 inc* 6 times	42 sc

8	*6 sc, 1 inc* 6 times	48 sc
9	*7 sc, 1 inc* 6 times	54 sc
10	*8 sc, 1 inc* 6 times	60 sc
11	*9 sc, 1 inc* 6 times	66 sc
12-24	(13 rnds) 1 sc in each stitch around	66 sc

Try the wig-cap on the head. You may need to add or omit a round to fit.

- 25 13 sc, \*1 sl.st. in next stitch, Ch 17, work down the chain, start in the 3<sup>rd</sup> chain from the hook, 1 hdc in each chain = 15 hdc\* 3 times,  
 8 sc (in round 24),  
 \*1 sl.st. in next stitch, Ch 8, work down the chain, start in the 2<sup>nd</sup> chain from the hook, 6 sc, 1 inc = 8 sc\* 3 times,  
 \*1 sl.st. in next stitch, Ch 7, work down the chain, start in the 2<sup>nd</sup> chain from the hook, 1 sc in each chain = 6 sc\* 11 times,  
 \*1 sl.st. in next stitch, Ch 8, work down the chain, start in the 2<sup>nd</sup> chain from the hook, 1 sc in each chain = 7 sc\* 3 times,  
 8 sc, \*1 sl.st. in next stitch, Ch 17, work down the chain, start in the 3<sup>rd</sup> chain from the hook, 1 hdc in each chain = 15 hdc\* 3 times,  
 14 sc (in round 24)

Fasten off with a slip stitch leaving a yarn tail long enough to sew the wig onto the head.



1. Place the wig on the doll and sew it to the head.
2. Pin the seventeen front strands of the wig and sew them onto the head as shown in the picture.
3. Braid the three strands on one side of the wig together all the way to the end and fasten with a rubber band (see photo).
4. Repeat step 3 for the second braid.
5. Using a piece of green ribbon make a bow on each braid.



### HAIRBAND With yarn B

Crochet hook 2,50mm.

Begin with chain 25.

Work in rows to make the hairband.

row		sts
1	1 inc in the 2 <sup>nd</sup> chain from the hook, turn	2 sc



2	Ch 1, 2 inc, turn	4 sc
3	Ch 1, 1 inc, 2 sc, 1 inc, turn	6 sc
4	Ch 1, 1 inc, 4 sc, 1 inc, turn	8 sc
5	Ch 1, 1 inc, 6 sc, 1 inc, turn	10 sc

Crochet rounds 6-65 in the **BACK LOOPS** only.

**6-65** (60 rows), Ch 1, 1 sl.st in each 10 sl.sts stitch across, turn

Work in both loops.

<b>66</b>	Ch 1, 1 dec, 6 sc, 1 dec, turn	8 sc
<b>67</b>	Ch 1, 1 dec, 4 sc, 1 dec, turn	6 sc
<b>68</b>	Ch 1, 1 dec, 2 sc, 1 dec, turn	4 sc
<b>69</b>	Ch 1, 2 dec, turn	2 sc
<b>70</b>	Ch 1, 1 dec, Ch 24	1 sc + Ch 24

Fasten off and weave in the ends.



### HAIRBAND EARS With yarn B and E

(Make two) Crochet hook 2,50mm.

We are going to make two pieces for each ear.

One with yarn E and one with yarn B

Begin with yarn E and chain 13.

rnd		sts
1	Start in the 2 <sup>nd</sup> chain from the hook, 2 sc, 2 hdc, 4 dc, 2 hdc, 2 sl.sts, work down the other side of the chain 2 sl.sts, 2 hdc, 4 dc, 2 hdc, 2 sc	24 sts

Fasten off and weave in the end.



With yarn **B** Repeat round **1** to make the second piece. **DO NOT** cut the yarn.  
Place both pieces together with their wrong sides facing each other and connect them by crocheting 1 sc in each stitch around and 1 inc on the top, working in **both** loops of the 1<sup>st</sup> piece and **both** loops of the 2<sup>nd</sup> piece (see photos).  
Fasten off leaving a yarn tail long enough to sew the ears onto the hairband.



Place the ears onto the hairband and pin them by leaving a space of 14 rows between them.  
Sew the ears onto the hairband and fasten off.



### BASKET With yarn **J**

Crochet hook **2,50mm**.

We are going to make two bases for the basket.

rnd		sts
1	6 sc in magic ring	6 sc
2	*Inc* 6 times	12 sc
3	*1 sc, 1 inc* 6 times	18 sc
4	1 sc, 1 inc, *2 sc, 1 inc* 5 times, 1 sc	24 sc
5	*3 sc, 1 inc* 6 times	30 sc
6	2 sc, 1 inc, *4 sc, 1 inc* 5 times, 2 sc	36 sc
7	*5 sc, 1 inc* 6 times	42 sc
8	3 sc, 1 inc, *6 sc, 1 inc* 5 times, 3 sc	48 sc
9	*7 sc, 1 inc* 6 times	54 sc
10	4 sc, 1 inc, *8 sc, 1 inc* 5 times, 4 sc	60 sc

Fasten off and weave in the end with the needle join method.

Repeat rounds **1-10** to make the second piece. **DO NOT** cut the yarn.



Place both pieces together with their wrong sides facing each other and connect them by crocheting 1 slip stitch in each stitch around, working in back loops of the 2<sup>nd</sup> piece and **both** loops of the 1<sup>st</sup> piece (see photo).  
Fasten off and weave in the end with the needle join method.  
Join yarn J and work in the left back loops of piece 1 (see photo).



rnd		sts
1	1 sc in each stitch around	60 sc
2-7	(6 rnds) *work in both loops, 2 sc, work in the <b>BACK</b> loops, 2 sc* 15 times	60 sc
8	1 sl.st. in each stitch around	60 sl.sts

DO NOT cut the yarn, chain 30, skip 30 stitches, join with a sl.st. in the 31<sup>st</sup> stitch of round 8 of the basket to create the strap.  
Work down the chain 30, 1 sl.st. in each chain across = 30 sl.sts.  
Fasten off and weave in the end.








**EGG** With yarn **K** ■, **L** ■, and **M** ■  
Stuff the egg as you go. Crochet hook **2,50mm**.

rnd		sts
1	6 sc in magic ring	6 sc
2	*Inc* 6 times	12 sc
3	*1 sc, 1 inc* 6 times	18 sc
4	1 sc in each stitch around	18 sc
5	*2 sc, 1 inc* 6 times	24 sc
6-11	(6 rnds) 1 sc in each stitch around	24 sc
12	*2 sc, 1 dec* 6 times	18 sc
13	*dec* 9 times	9 sc
14	4 dec, 1 sl.st.	5 sts

Break the yarn and close the remaining hole.  
Weave in the yarn tail through the front loop of each remaining stitch and pull tight to close.  
Make a knot and hide the remaining yarn tail.  
Repeat rounds 1-14 to make two more eggs.



## ASSEMBLY OF THE DOLL

-  Sew the wig onto Lily's head.
-  Sew the applique onto the dress.
-  Sew the buttons to the shoes.
-  Sew the ears onto the hairband.
-  Dress your doll with the dress and hairband.
-  Put a little bit of blush on her cheeks.
-  Give your doll her basket to hold.
