Pattern includes:

- wizards doll (boy and girl)
- cloak
- scarf
- hat
- mini-pumpkin
- glasses

This pattern does not include crochet and knitting tutorials and requires basic skills.

Materials & supplies:

- 1. Yarn: YarnArt Jeans (50g/160m).
 - for the scarf I used DROPS NORD MIX (50g/170m), but you can use any yarn.
 - for girl hair I used Mondial Superwool (50g/125m), but you can use any yarn.
- 2. Hook: 1,15 mm (you can use hook of any size which is comfortable for you)
- 3. 2 black beads for eyes: 4-5mm
- 4. White thread of any thickness for eyes
- 5. 2 buttons for a bag: 6-7mm.
- 6. Fiber filling. You can use glass granulate to make toy heavier.
- 7. Big tapestry needle for sewing details together
- 8. Pins
- 9. Scissors
- 10. Stitch marker to mark the beginning of each round (I use black thread)
- 11. Pastel crayons for toning the toy (or oil pastels)

Abbreviations:

Crochet:

ch - chain

SI st - slip stitch

Sc - single crochet

Hdc - half double crochet

inc - increase (2sc in one st)

dec - decrease (2 st together)

R- row/round

- (..) number of stitches in a round/row
- ()*... repeat instructions in brackets ... times

BOY

Legs, body:

Use black yarn.

First leg:

1 R - 6sc in magic ring

Place the marker at the beginning of the round.

 $2R - (1sc, inc) \times 3$ (9)

3-4 R - 9sc (2 Rs)

5 R - 2sc, 2dec, 3sc (7)

Change yarn to brown color:

6 R - 1sc, 2dec, 2sc (5)

7 R - 1sc, inc, 3sc (6)

8 R - 1sc, 4inc, 1sc (10)

9 R - 4sc, inc, 5sc (11)

10 R - 5sc, inc, 5sc (12)

11 R - 5sc, 2inc, 5sc (14)

12-15 R - 14sc (4 Rs)

16 R - 3sc (don't finish the row)

Fasten off. Cut the yarn.

Second leg, body:

Repeat round of R 1-15 of first leg. Don't fasten off.

Attention: Everybody has different crochet tension and if you see that the row ends are not symmetrical on both legs (inner side), just crochet 1 sc more or 1 sc less if needed.

Continue: chain 4 and join the first leg with slip stitch. While joining the legs, the feet should point forwards you.



Place the marker to mark the beginning of the round. 16 R - 14 sc around the first leg, 4 sc (1 st in each st of the chain), 14 sc around the second leg, 4sc (1 st in each st of the chain) (36)

17 R - 14sc, inc, 2sc, inc, 14sc, inc, 2sc, inc (40) 18-30 R - 40sc (13 Rs) Start stuffing the legs.

Crochet 9-10 sc to move the beginning of the row to the left and change the color of the yarn to white. The place where the yarn color changes should be on the side of the toy.

31-39 R - 40sc (9 Rs)

Start to make decreases on the sides of the toy. Crochet 1-2 sc to move the beginning of the row, <u>so decreases</u> would be evenly on the sides of the toy. Place the marker to mark the beginning of the round. Stuff it as you go.

40 R - (dec, 18sc)×2 (38)

41 R - 38sc

42 R - (dec, 17sc)×2 (36)

43 R - 36sc

44 R - (dec, 4sc)×6 (30)

45 R - 30sc

46 R - (dec, 3sc)×6 (24)

47 R - 24cs

48 R - (dec, 2sc)×6 (18)

49 R - 18sc

If you plan to make cotter pin jointed head, place the cotter pin now. I attach the head to the body by sewing. $50 R - (dec, 1sc) \times 6 (12)$

51 R - 6 dec

Fasten off. Close hole. Leave long tail for assembly.



Head:

Use beige yarn.

1R-6sc in magic ring

2 R - inc×6 (12)

Place the marker to mark the beginning of the round.

3 R - (1sc, inc)×6 (18)

4 R - (2sc, inc)×6 (24)

 $5R - (3sc, inc) \times 6(30)$

6 R - (4sc, inc)×6 (36)

7 R - (5sc, inc)×6 (42)

8 R - (6sc, inc)×6 (48)

9-15 R - 48sc (7 Rs)

16 R - (6sc, dec)×6 (42)

17 R - (5sc, dec)×6 (36)

18 R - (4sc, dec)×6 (30)

19 R - (3sc, dec)×6 (24)

If you plan to make cotter pin jointed head, place the cotter pin now in 1 row (in magic ring). I attach the head to the body by sewing.

Stuff head tight. 22 R - 6dec

Fasten off. Close hole. Hide yarn tail inside the detail.



Arms:

Use beige yarn. 1 R - 5sc in magic ring 2-5 R - 5sc (4 Rs) Change yarn to white color: 6 R - inc, 4sc (6)
7-22 R - 6sc (16 Rs)

Stuff arms with fiber fill approximately to round 15 only. Flatten the detail and make 3sc through both layers. Fasten off. Cut the yarn leaving a long tail for assembly. Make 2 details.



Ears:

Use beige yarn.

1 R - 4sc in magic ring

2 R - inc×4 (8)

 $3R - (2sc, dec) \times 2 (6)$

Flatten the detail and make 3sc through both layers. Fasten off. Cut the yarn leaving a long tail for assembly. Make 2 details.



Hair (cap):

Use brown yarn.

1R-6sc in magic ring

2 R - inc×6 (12)

Place the marker to mark the beginning of the round.

3 R - (1sc, inc)×6 (18)

4 R - (2sc, inc)×6 (24)

5 R - (3sc, inc)×6 (30)

6 R - (4sc, inc)×6 (36)

7 R - (5sc, inc)×6 (42)

8 R - (6sc, inc)×6 (48)

9 R - (7sc, inc)×6 (54)

10-16 R - 54sc (7 Rs)

Fasten off. Cut the yarn leaving a long tail for assembly.



Assembling:

- 1. Attach the head (closed hole down) to the body approximately on 49-50 row.
- 2. Sew arms on the sides of the body at the level of rows 46-47.
- 3. Sew the ears at the level of 12-14 rows.
- 4. Make the hair. Put the cap on the head of the toy and sew it with basting stitches.

Cut pieces of brown yarn measuring 6-8 cm. We will fasten the yarn pieces around the cap by pulling the yarn through both cap and head making a loop:



Pull both thread ends through this loop:



Make hair around the entire circumference of the cap as described above:



Trim and brush hair:



5. Sew eyes to the head at the level of rows 13-14. Embroider eyes shadows with white thread as shown in the photo below:




6. If necessary, you can make an eye tightening, as shown in the photo:



- 7. Sew eyebrows at 12-13 rows.
- 8. Tint the toy with oil pastels:

- tint around the eyes with brown color.
- put blush on the cheeks
- make spots in black color on the cheeks (or embroider them).
- 9. Embroider the nose as shown in the photos below (Make a loop at the level of 14-15 rows, tighten it. Make several turns of the thread around this loop so that the nose turns out to be voluminous):



- 10. Sew on 3 buttons in the center of the belly.
- 11. The finished toy looks like this:



HAT

Use black yarn.

1R-6sc in magic ring

Place the marker to mark the beginning of the round.

$$2R - (1sc, inc) \times 3$$
 (9)

$$6 R - (3sc, inc) \times 3 (15)$$

$$8R - (4sc, inc) \times 3$$
 (18)

$$10 R - (5sc, inc) \times 3$$
 (21)

19 R - (9sc, inc)×6 (66)

20 R - (10sc, inc)×6 (72)

21 R - (11sc, inc)×6 (78)

22R - 78sl st

Fasten off. Cut the yarn leaving a long tail for assembly.



Sew the hat to the head with basting stitches.

CLOAK

Use black yarn. Chain 34.

1 R - start from the 3rd stitch from the hook: 32hdc

Next, we will crochet not in a circle, but in the opposite direction. Turn work after each row.

2 R - chain 2, 3hdc, inc, (5hdc, inc)×4, 4hdc (37)

3 R - chain 2, 1hdc, 4inc, chain 4, skip 6 stitches, (1hdc, inc)×7, chain 4, skip 6 stitches, 4inc, 2hdc (48)

4 R - chain 2, 48hdc (48)

5 R - chain 2, (11hdc, inc)×4 (52)

6 R - chain 2, 52 hdc (52)

7 R - chain 2, (inc, 12hdc)×4 (56)

8 R - chain 2, 56hdc (56)

9 R - chain 2, (13hdc, inc)×4 (60)

10 R - chain 2, (inc, 14hdc)×4 (64)

11-12 R - chain 2, 64hdc (2Rs)

13 R - chain 2, (inc, 15hdc)×4 (68)

14-22 R - chain 2, 68hdc (9 Rs)



Cut the yarn, fasten off and hide the tail of the yarn.

Sleeves:

The sleeve hole consists of 12 loops: 6 loops at the top of the hole, 4 loops at the bottom of the hole and one loop on the sides.

Start crocheting the sleeves from the first of the 6 top loops, as shown in the photo:



We will crochet the sleeve in continuous rounds from left to right:

1 R- 6hdc, 6sl st (12) 2 R - 6hdc, 6sl st (12) 3-4 R - 6hdc, 6sl st (2 Rs) 5-6 R - 12hdc (2 Rs) 7 R - (inc, 5hdc)×2 (14) 8-9 R - 14hdc (2 Rs) 10 R - (inc, 6hdc)×2 (16) 11-15 R - 16hdc (5 Rs) 16 R - 16sl st

Cut the yarn, fasten off and hide the tail of the yarn.

Make the second sleeve in the same way.



Collar:

Chain 34.

1 R - start from the 3rd stitch from the hook: 32hdc

Next, we will crochet not in a circle, but in the opposite direction. Turn work after each row.

2 R - chain 2, (7hdc, inc)×4 (36)

3 R - chain 2, (8hdc, inc)×4 (40)

4 R - chain 2, (9hdc, inc)×4 (44)



Sew the collar to the cloak.

Make two ties. Chain of 45 and crochet 45 sl sts backwards:



SCARF

Use orange yarn. Chain 5.

1R - start from the 2^{nd} stitch from the hook: 4 sc (4)

Turn work after each row.

2R - chain 1, 4 sc (4)

Repeat 2R until your scarf has the desired length (80-100 rows).


Fasten off, cut the yarn and hide the end of the tread.



GLASSES

You can buy glasses in the store (I purchased them in the Ali-Express online store at the link: https://a.aliexpress.com/_9x29r2) or make it yourself:

Take a 1mm thick steel wire and bend it to fit the glasses. Any suitable rectangular object (eraser, pencil or similar) can be used to shape the glasses by wrapping the wire around it.



In order for the glasses to be more firmly attached to the toy, their tips can be bent.

MINI PUMPKIN

Use orange yarn.

1 R - 6sc in magic ring

Place the marker to mark the beginning of the round.

2 R - inc×6 (12)

 $3 R - (1sc, inc) \times 6 (18)$

4 R - (2sc, inc)×6 (24)

 $5R - (3sc, inc) \times 6(30)$

6-10 R - 30 sc (5 Rs)

11 R - (3sc, dec)×6 (24)

12 R - (2sc, dec)×6 (18)

13 R - (1sc, dec)×6 (12)

Stuffing the pumpkin.

Now we start to crochet the pumpkin stem. Change yarn to brown color.

15 R - 8sc

16 R - 6sc, 2 sl st (8)

17 R - (2sc, dec)×2 (6)

30 R - 4sc, 2 sl st (6)

 $31 R - (1sc, dec) \times 2 (4)$

Cut the yarn, close the hole, fasten off and hide the tail of the yarn:



Now we need to shape the "pumpkin" as shown in the photos below. Make tightenings from the bottom of the pumpkin stem.

Make 4 -8 tightenings:



GIRL

Legs, body:

Use black yarn.

First leg:

1 R - 6sc in magic ring

Place the marker at the beginning of the round.

 $2R - (1sc, inc) \times 3$ (9)

3-4 R - 9sc (2 Rs)

5 R - 2sc, 2dec, 3sc (7)

6 R - 1sc, 2dec, 2sc (5)

7 R - 1sc, inc, 3sc (6)

8 R - 1sc, 4inc, 1sc (10)

9 R - 4sc, inc, 5sc (11)

10 R - 5sc, inc, 5sc (12)

11-15 R - 12sc (5 Rs)

16 R - 2sc (don't finish the row)

Fasten off. Cut the yarn.

Second leg, body:

Repeat round of R 1-14 of first leg.

15 R - 11sc (don't finish the row)

Don't fasten off.

Attention: Everybody has different crochet tension and if you see that the row ends are not symmetrical on both legs (inner side), just crochet 1 sc more or 1 sc less if needed.

Continue: chain 6 and join the first leg with slip stitch. While joining the legs, the feet should point forwards you.



Place the marker to mark the beginning of the round.

16 R - 12 sc around the first leg, 6 sc (1 st in each st of the chain), 12 sc around the second leg, 6sc (1 st in each st of the chain) (36)

17 R - 12sc, inc, 4sc, inc, 12sc, inc, 4sc, inc (40)

18-27 R - 40sc (10 Rs)

Start stuffing the legs.

Crochet 7-9 sc to move the beginning of the row to the left and change the color of the yarn to white. The place where the yarn color changes should be on the side of the toy.

28-39 R - 40sc (12 Rs)

Start to make decreases on the sides of the toy. Crochet 1-3 sc to move the beginning of the row, <u>so decreases</u> would be evenly on the sides of the toy. Place the marker to mark the beginning of the round. Stuff it as you go.

40 R - (dec, 18sc)×2 (38)

41 R - 38sc

42 R - (dec, 17sc)×2 (36)

43 R - 36sc

44 R - (dec, 4sc)×6 (30)

45 R - 30sc

46 R - (dec, 3sc)×6 (24)

47 R - 24cs

48 R - (dec, 2sc)×6 (18)

49 R - 18sc

If you plan to make cotter pin jointed head, place the cotter pin now. I attach the head to the body by sewing. $50 R - (dec, 1sc) \times 6 (12)$

51 R - 6 dec

Fasten off. Close hole. Leave long tail for assembly.



Head, arms, ears:

Make details in the same way as in the boy pattern.

HAT

1-17 R - make in the same way as in the boy pattern.

18 R - 54sl st

Fasten off. Cut the yarn leaving a long tail for assembly.



Assembling:

- 1. Attach the head (closed hole down) to the body approximately on 49-50 row.
- 2. Sew arms on the sides of the body at the level of rows 46-47.
- 3. Making a skirt. We will crochet with green yarn at the level of 34-35 rows. Enter the hook under of the sc, pick up the green thread and pull it through to make a loop:



Pull the working thread through the loop and tighten as shown in the photo below:



1R - Crochet 40sc in a circle to the end of the row:





Connect the beginning and the end of the row with sl st. Next, we will crochet in a circle (spirals). Place the marker to mark the beginning of the round.

2-3 R - 40hdc (2 Rs)

4 R - inc×40 (80)

5-13 R - 80hdc (9 Rs)

14 R - 80sl st

Cut the yarn, fasten off and hide the tail of the yarn



- 4. Sew the ears at the level of 12-14 rows.
- 5. Make the hair. Cut orange yarn to pieces 20-25 cm long. Will fasten the hair from the very top of the head (first row of the head) as shown in the photo below.

Enter the hook under one of the sc, pick up the orange thread and pull it through to make a loop:



Pull both ends of the tread through this loop:



In the same way, make hair (every other sc) up to 9 rows around the head.

Further, fasten the hair only behind the head (between the ears) through one row up to 17 row.



Tie the hair in a ponytail, as shown in the photo below:





6. Sew eyes to the head at the level of rows 13-14. Embroider eyes shadows with white thread as shown in the photo below:



7. If necessary, you can make an eye tightening, as shown in the photo:



8. Sew eyebrows at 12-13 rows.

9. Embroider the nose as shown in the photos below (Make a loop at the level of 14-15 rows, tighten it. Make several turns of the thread around this loop so that the nose turns out to be voluminous):









10. Tint the toy with pastels:

- tint around the eyes with brown color.
- put blush on the cheeks
- make spots in black color on the cheeks (or embroider them).



- 11. Sew on 3 buttons in the center of the belly.
- 12. Sew the hat to the head with basting stitches.
- 13. Put a coat and a scarf on the doll.

Congratulations on the creation of your new babies! You can use a toothpick as a magic wand!
