3 back post double crochets into the 1 stitch

5 front post double crochets into the 1 stitch

double crochet, chain stitch, double crochets into the 1 stitch

double crochet, 2 chain stitch, double crochets into the 1 stitch

double crochet, chain stitch, 3 double crochets into the 1 stitch

3 double crochets into the 1 stitch


4 double crochets into the 1 stitch


5 double crochets into the 1 stitch

7 double crochets into the 1 stitch


9 double crochets in the magic circle

2 double crochet, chain stitch, 2 double crochets into the 1 stitch






Kupidyn shawl part 2






Kupidyn shawl part 3






Kupidyn shawl part 4
