

Abbreviations

st − stitch

sts — stitches

ch — chain

sl st — slip stitch

sc — single crochet

hdc — half double crochet

dc — double crochet

tr — treble crochet

dtr — double treble crochet

Materials Used

- Brand name Mimoza, 100g=330m, 100% acrylic. You need 1.5 skeins.
- Crochet hook size 3 .
- Scissors.
- Wire 2,5m .
- Cotton wool to fill the inside of the hat.
- Darning needle to weave in ends.
- Pieces of fabric to fill a hat. You can use fabric from your old shirt for example.

Part 1

row1= Magic loop, ch3, 5 dc

row1-11 = 6 dc

row12 = 9 dc (1 st, 2 dc in 1 st in between)

row13 = 12 dc (1 st, 2 dc in 1 st in between)

row14 = 12dc



Part 2

Row1 = 18 dc(1 st, 2 dc in 1 st in between) Row2-14= 18 dc

Part 3

Row1 = 36 dc(2dc in 1 st)

Row 2-9 = 36 dc

Part 4

Row1 = 54 dc (1 st 2 dc, 1 st in between)

Row2 = 72 dc (1 st 2 dc, 2 st in between)

Row3 = 90 dc (1st 2 dc, 3 st in between)

Part 5

Row1-8=90 dc

Part 6

Row1 = 108 dc (1st 2 dc, 4 st in between)

Row2 = 126 dc (1st 2 dc, 5 st in between)

Row3 = $144 \, dc \, (1st \, 2 \, dc, \, 6 \, st \, in \, between)$

Row4 = 162 dc (1st 2 dc, 7 st in between)

Row5 = $180 \, dc \, (1st \, 2 \, dc, \, 8 \, st \, in \, between)$

Row6 = 198 dc (1st 2 dc, 9 st in between)

Row7 = 216 dc (1st 2 dc, 10 st in between)

Row8 = 234 dc (1st 2 dc, 11 st in between)



Rows on a hat



Start from 18 row on a hat Row1 = sc in each st

Row2 = 1st 2 sc

Skip 3 rows of hat Repeat 8x



Give shape



Take a 90 cm/35.4 in wire, fold it in half and wrap the end of hat.

Fill the hat with cotton wool and pieces of fabric





This is what it looks linside

We need to close this circle

Circle

Row1: magic loop, ch 3, 9 dc

Row2 = 20 dc (1 st 2 dc)

Row3 = 30 dc (1st 2 dc, 1 st)

in between)

Row4 = 40 dc (1 st 2 dc, 2 st)

in between)

Row5: 1 st 2 sc.

Sewing circle to hat hole

inside.












Fix the wire along the edge of the cap of sc



Fix the ends of the wire as shown in the photo and wrap with thread
